

DAY 11 — Thankful for Hope

Verse: “We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure.” — Hebrews 6:19

Hope is one of the most powerful gifts God gives us — because hope keeps us going when everything else tells us to give up. There are seasons when hope feels easy. When prayers are answered quickly. When life makes sense. When the future looks bright and predictable. And then there are seasons when hope feels fragile. When answers don’t come. When waiting stretches longer than expected. When life doesn’t turn out the way we thought it would. As long as you’re breathing, there is hope. As long as God is working, there is hope. And as long as Jesus lives, hope is alive.

Be thankful today for the hope that holds you steady — not because life is perfect, but because God is faithful.

Lord, today we thank You for the gift of hope — the hope that anchors our souls and keeps us steady in every season. Thank You for being our source of strength when life feels uncertain and our future feels unclear. For those listening who feel discouraged, weary, or close to giving up, restore their hope today. Remind them that You are still working behind the scenes and that their story is far from over. Help us hold tightly to Your promises and trust You even when we don't understand the journey.
