

DAY 6 — Thankful for Provision

Verse: “My God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.” — *Philippians 4:19*

Provision doesn’t always look like what we expected — but it always looks like God.

We often think of provision as big blessings, but most of God’s provision shows up in quiet, everyday ways:

- groceries that stretch further than they should
- bills somehow paid when the math doesn’t add up
- an unexpected check in the mail
- a new job at just the right time
- a friend showing up with dinner when you’re overwhelmed
- peace that settles your heart during financial stress

Sometimes God provides through miracles we can’t explain.

Sometimes He provides through people.

Sometimes He provides through opportunities.

Sometimes He provides through wisdom — teaching us when to wait, when to save, and when to say no.

And sometimes... His provision is simply *strength* to get through the season we’re in.

When we’re walking through tight places, it’s easy to ask “Why is this happening?” or “How will we make it?”

But over and over again, Scripture reminds us:

God is not a God of lack. He is a God of abundance. He knows what we need before we even ask. Not always what we *want*.

But always what we *need*. Think back over your life — how many times did you worry yourself sick over something that God eventually worked out anyway?

How many nights did you cry over a bill, a situation, a deadline, a loss... only to look back later and say, “God carried me through that”? He has a perfect record.

Never once has He failed His people.

Never once has He ignored a need.

Never once has He forgotten a child of His.

So today, even if you’re in a season of stretching or uncertainty, be thankful that God is still Jehovah Jireh — **the God who provides.**

He’s providing right now in ways you can’t see yet.

He’s setting things in motion.

He’s aligning resources.

He’s opening the right doors and closing the wrong ones.

And He’s preparing blessings that will show up right on time — not a moment too early, and never a moment too late.

That’s something to be thankful for today.

Lord, today we thank You for being our Provider — our source for every need, every comfort, and every blessing. Thank You for supplying us daily with the things we often overlook: food, shelter, work, strength, support, and hope. For the person listening who is stressed about finances, worried about bills, or unsure about tomorrow, remind them that You are faithful. Remind them that You see every need, hear every prayer, and already have a plan in motion. Teach us to trust Your timing and Your wisdom. Help us recognize the ways You provide that aren’t always flashy or obvious, but are always loving and intentional. We are grateful that our lives are in Your hands and that You never fail. In Jesus’ Name we pray, Amen.
