

## LOVED FIRST

### Day Three — Draw Near

**Scripture** *“Come near to God and He will come near to you.”*

— James 4:8 (NIV)

Healthy relationships grow through closeness. They deepen when time is spent, attention is given, and communication is intentional. Our relationship with God is no different.

Drawing near to God doesn't require perfect words or flawless faith. It simply requires willingness. God is not waiting for us to get everything right before welcoming us closer—He invites us as we are.

Often, we assume distance from God is caused by His absence, when in reality it comes from our distractions. Life gets loud, schedules fill up, and spiritual connection becomes crowded out by busyness. Yet Scripture assures us that when we take even a small step toward God, He responds with nearness.

God's desire is relationship, not ritual. He longs for our presence more than our performance. When we draw near, we begin to recognize His voice, His guidance, and His peace more clearly.

## **Real-Life Example**

Think about a relationship that grew stronger simply because you spent more time together—sharing conversations, listening, and being present. The same is true with God. Even a few intentional moments in prayer or Scripture can deepen your connection with Him.

## **Reflection Questions**

- What distractions keep me from spending time with God?
- How can I intentionally draw near to Him today?

## **Prayer**

Lord, help me draw near to You with a willing heart. Quiet the distractions around me so I can experience Your presence more fully. In Jesus Name We Pray, Amen.

## **Action Step**

Set aside a few intentional minutes today—without distractions—to simply be with God.
