

LOVED FIRST

Day Two — Love That Doesn't Change

Scripture *“For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers... will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”* — Romans 8:38–39 (NIV)

Much of the love we experience in life feels conditional. It grows when expectations are met and fades when they are not. Over time, this can shape how we think God loves us—as if His love rises and falls with our performance.

But God's love does not work that way.

Scripture reminds us that nothing can separate us from His love—not failure, not doubt, not disappointment, and not difficult seasons. God's love remains steady when our emotions fluctuate and our circumstances change.

This unchanging love becomes an anchor for our faith. When life feels unstable, God's love stays firm. When we question our worth, His love answers with assurance. We may struggle to remain faithful at times, but God never struggles to remain loving.

Understanding this truth allows us to stop striving for approval and start resting in grace. God's love is not fragile—it is faithful.

Real-Life Example

Think about a relationship that shifted when expectations weren't met. Now imagine a love that never wavers—one that remains present in both success and failure. That is the kind of love God offers you every day.

Reflection Questions

- Do I believe God's love changes based on my actions?
- How would my faith grow if I trusted God's love as constant?

Prayer

God, thank You that Your love does not change. Help me rest in the security of Your faithfulness, even when I feel uncertain. In Jesus Name We Pray, Amen.

Action Step

When doubt arises today, remind yourself: *God's love for me has not changed.*
