

## RELATIONSHIPS DEVOTIONAL

### Today: Choosing the Right Partner

**Scripture:** *"Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers..."* — 2 Corinthians 6:14

Few decisions shape your life more than choosing a partner.

We spend time choosing careers, houses, vehicles, and plans—but the person you choose to walk beside you will influence your faith, your peace, your purpose, and often generations after you.

The right relationship doesn't mean finding someone perfect.

It means finding someone who is walking in the same direction you are.

Attraction may start a relationship. Chemistry may create excitement. But character is what sustains it.

A partner should not pull you further from God—they should encourage you toward Him.

Ask yourself:

- Do they respect my values?
- Do they speak life or create constant confusion?
- Do they help me become more like Christ?
- Can we pray together?
- Do they demonstrate kindness, humility, and faithfulness?

God never designed relationships to leave us empty, fearful, or constantly compromising who He created us to be.

The wrong partner can distract purpose.

The right partner can strengthen purpose.

That doesn't mean life becomes easy—it means you are carrying life's burdens alongside someone committed to growing with God and with you.

If you are waiting for the right person, don't rush because of loneliness.

If you are in a relationship, ask God to reveal whether it reflects His design.

And if you've made mistakes in relationships before, remember this: God's grace is bigger than your past decisions.

Your relationship status does not determine your value.

God's timing and God's peace are worth waiting for.

**Prayer:**

Father, give me wisdom in my relationships. Help me not choose based only on feelings but on faith, character, and purpose. Lead me toward relationships that honor You and protect my heart from connections that pull me away from Your best. In Jesus Name WE Pray Amen.

**Reflection Question:**

Am I choosing relationships based on temporary feelings—or lasting values?

**Today's Challenge:**

Write down the qualities you are praying for in a partner—and then ask yourself if you are becoming that kind of person too.
