Scripture: *"Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind."* — **Matthew 22:37**

Devotional

Every relationship requires commitment.

Friendships require loyalty. Marriages require faithfulness. Families require grace. But the greatest commitment we'll ever make isn't to another person—it's to God.

When Jesus is at the center of our lives, every other relationship benefits. We love more deeply because we've experienced His love. We forgive more freely because we've been forgiven. We extend grace because we've received grace.

The world encourages us to make another person our priority, but God calls us to seek **Him first** (Matthew 6:33). When our vertical relationship with God is healthy, our horizontal relationships become healthier too.
