WMUZ Announces Major Lineup Shift: “The Tom Jordan Show” Moves to Morning Drive; Lorenzo Sewell Debuts “Politics and Praise” in Afternoon

“Tom’s ability to connect with listeners on both a personal and spiritual level makes him a natural fit for morning drive,” said General Manager Frank Franciosi. “His experience, credibility, and heart for ministry will help set a meaningful tone for our audience each day.”

As part of the lineup change, WMUZ also welcomes Lorenzo Sewell as its new afternoon drive host (4:00–7:00 p.m.). Sewell will launch his show, “Politics and Praise,” bringing a dynamic and compelling voice shaped by real-life experience, cultural awareness, and a passion for engaging in meaningful dialogue. He gained national recognition after delivering a prayer at the inauguration marking Donald Trump’s second presidential term, reflecting his growing influence as a faith leader engaged in both spiritual and cultural conversations.

“Lorenzo Sewell brings an authentic, powerful voice that speaks directly to the heart of our mission,” Franciosi added. “His ability to communicate truth with clarity, passion, and relevance will resonate deeply with our listeners.”

Together, these changes represent a strategic investment in WMUZ’s commitment to delivering impactful, uplifting programming during key listening hours. Listeners can expect engaging conversation, timely insight, and spiritually enriching content throughout the day.
