- Perform analytical material characterization testing notably ICP-OES, various titrations, and analytical equipment.
- May collect or log in samples for testing in LIMS.
- Solve technical problems related to routine testing.
- Follow test plans and protocols.
- Analyze tests results and report results/conclusions.
- Performs troubleshooting on lab equipment as required.
- Run and enter Quality Checks per Quality Assurance Program
- Report test progress to management.
- Observe all company, state and federal safety and environmental regulations.
- Assist with waste and chemical management.
- Maintain a clean and productive lab environment by following a 6S program.
