Development & Review Process

This curriculum was selected following a 1.5-year district-wide ELA review and pilot process, which included:

- Classroom pilots of sample units using Savvas and other curriculums
- Study of current literacy research including Science of Reading, High Leverage Practices, Iowa Core Standards, and dyslexia.
- Ongoing team collaboration and feedback

Professional Learning & Support Plan

 - Focused on implementation, co-teaching, reflection, and high-leverage strategies
