## **lowa Firefighters Memorial - Wall Expansion Project**

Project Cost:

\$300,000

Money already raised:

\$125,000

Fundraising still needed: \$175,000

Benefits: The Iowa Firefighters Memorial location provides a location where all Iowa Firefighters who have served their communities or have given the ultimate sacrifice in a Line Of Duty Death, have their names engraved on a stone wall for perpetual remembrance at a very honorable and sacred location. This memorial is dedicated to all Past, Present, and Future Iowa Firefighters!

Purpose of Memorial Wall: Iowa Firefighters Memorial idea was born in 1988. The realization of the memorial occurred in 1990, when the lowa Firemen's Association commissioned a bronze statue to be placed at the memorial site in Coralville, Iowa. The site work began in 1992 and the Iowa Firefighters Memorial was dedicated on April 10, 1994. This memorial stands as a "Tribute to ALL Iowa Firefighters" with a lasting memorial for their service to their communities and the State of lowa. One expansion with the addition of another granite wall was completed in 2010. The original walls will likely be filled within the next 3-4 years and plans for another wall expansion fundraiser have started. It is anticipated that the construction will begin in either the fall of 2025 or the summer of 2026.
