On January 1, 2026 at 3:18 a.m., the Hampton Police Department responded to a report of multiple shots fired in the 300-block 12th Ave NE in Hampton. Witnesses reported hearing shots fired and responding officers recovered evidence of gunfire. The subsequent investigation determined no persons were struck by gunfire and a person of interest was developed. Two victims were identified and the shooting followed a verbal argument.

Based on the investigation, Victor Ivan Ferman-Nava, 22, of Coulter, was arrested and is at the Franklin County Law Enforcement Center where he is awaiting a court appearance.

Victor Ferman-Nava

Intimidation with a Dangerous Weapon

Assault while Displaying a Dangerous Weapon

6 counts of Reckless use of Firearm

Hampton Police Department was assisted by Franklin County Sheriff's Office, and the Franklin County Attorney's Office.
