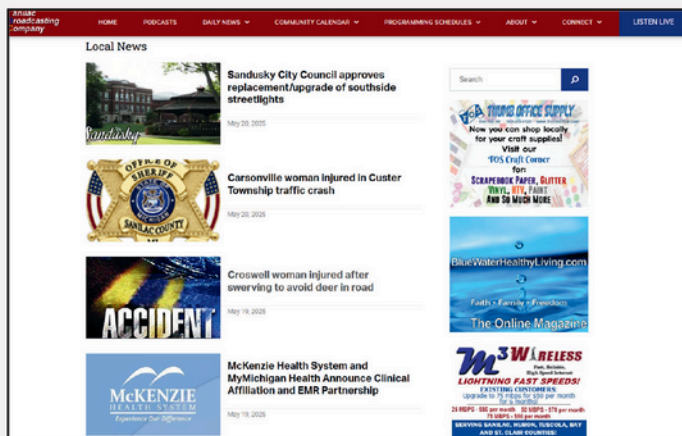

A Thumbful of Fun for the Whole Family, from Huron to Tuscola County!

Summer in the Thumb means plenty of sunshine and long walks along Lake Huron—or the nearest body of water in general—but who can forget a favorite pastime of residents: festivals (and fairs)! With over 80 happening from early June through late August, there is no shortage of fun to be had. There is also just not enough time to cover them all, which means that sometimes the smaller events get left behind. From the wacky to the historical, there are plenty of activities out there that are sure to impress even the most knowledgeable of festival-goers.

Without diving too deep into its history, Szymanski's Creekside Acres in Port Austin hosts various seasonal workshops throughout the year. The Sunflower Trail, in particular, sprouted up two years ago and has remained a prominent attraction for locals and those outside of Huron County, especially since it has ties to the 4-H program. Sunflowers & Fluffy Cows Weekend is technically a mini-festival, but it is sure to still be 'bovine!' From Friday, August 15, through Sunday, August 17, you can take part in a weekend-long birthday celebration for Zoey, the mini highland heifer. Tickets are available for \$7 and allow access to the Sunflower Trail, a petting zoo, face painting, the Kids' Zone, and more.

On the more historical side of things, Sanilac County is gearing up for a return to form in 2025. Pioneer Days has a bit of an obscure history, undergoing several name changes over the years. It is believed that this festival sprang from the theatrical performances held on the "City of Croswell" showboat during the 1960s. While the mystery of what happened to the boat is a story for another day, in the spirit of its celebrations, a festival was devised and (officially) dubbed "Pioneer Days" in 1982. It would later be renamed in 1999 the "Swinging Bridge Festival," following minor financial disagreements. A final change occurred in 2017, which returned it to its former namesake. Even though the pandemic did interrupt things a touch, with the help of dedicated volunteers, Pioneer Days is set to take sail again on Saturday, July 12, in Croswell. Attendees can look forward to family-friendly activities like cardboard boat races, local music, and food trucks.

Make sure you bring the 'sun-scream' for this next event, as the monsters are roaring their way back to

St. Clair County for the 3rd Annual FrankenFest. If you have ever wanted to celebrate Halloween in the summer, then this is the perfect festival for you. You can join in on the festivities on Saturday, June 28, from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. at the Fort Gratiot Lighthouse in Port Huron. As one of the oldest lighthouses in Michigan, it will double as an educational opportunity for those who wish to learn more about its history or for hunting ghosts. FrankenFest is a free outdoor festival, and with food trucks, aerial shows, and over 100 artists and vendors, there is sure to be something for every creature. So, attendees beware, you might just be in for a scare.

As one of the more recent traditions set to take the stage, Lapeer County's 4th Annual PorchFest is a great way to support local artists and bands alike. Pull up a chair on Sunday, July 19, from 8 a.m. until 6 p.m., and spend some time visiting performers on residential porches or lawns throughout downtown Lapeer. Many of the details have been shrouded in mystery in the lead-up to the big day, but previous PorchFests have featured over 20 artists spread across 10 or more stages. And the best part? Everyone has their own time block, which means less of a chance that you miss anyone. As a sneak peek, The Twisted River Band, a group of Americana musicians who specialize in rock, bluegrass, and country, will be performing from noon until 6 p.m.

Food trucks are another typical feature at many festivals, which might leave you wondering how it is possible to create a whole festival around them. The Funtown Chowdown Food Truck Festival took that challenge to heart and even went a step further in the process. It originally found its wheels in 2017 as a one day offering for those in Frankenmuth, featuring 10 trucks and a crowd of hungry visitors. Due to its overwhelming popularity, it has since expanded. Food truck connoisseurs can expect a special surprise this year with themed events, including a Wild West day on June 12, Christmas in July on July 10, Carnival on August 14, and Patriot(ic) on September 11. And, as a bonus, both parking and festival admission are free.
