

YANCEY COUNTY PROCLAMATION OF A

COUNTY STATE OF EMERGENCY (REVISED 10/4/24)

- 1. Pursuant to the Yancey County State of Emergency Ordinance and Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statues and Article 36A, Chapter 14 of the North Carolina General Statutes, I have determined that a State of Emergency as defined in the Yancey County State of Emergency Ordinance, exists in the County of Yancey because there is an imminent threat of severe damage, injury or loss of life or property resulting from the impending TROPICAL STORM HELENE, and the remnants of the storm.
- 2. I, therefore, proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency in the County of Yancey. The following restrictions and prohibitions are imposed:
 - A. **CURFEW**: Yancey County is under a curfew from 9:00 pm till 7:00 am. Beginning at 9:00 pm on Friday, October 4th, 2024, until 7:00 am on Friday, October 11th, 2024; except for medical emergencies or persons traveling to and from work.
- 3. I hereby order all county law enforcement officer, county employees and all other Emergency Management personnel subject to my control to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of provisions of the County Emergency Ordinance, including those which are set forth below:

All civilian and Emergency Management and Public Safety personnel are ordered to comply with the Emergency Operations plan.

- 4. This proclamation shall include the incorporated Town of Burnsville, through and by consent of its Mayor.
- 5. This proclamation shall become effective immediately and shall remain in effect until rescinded.
