

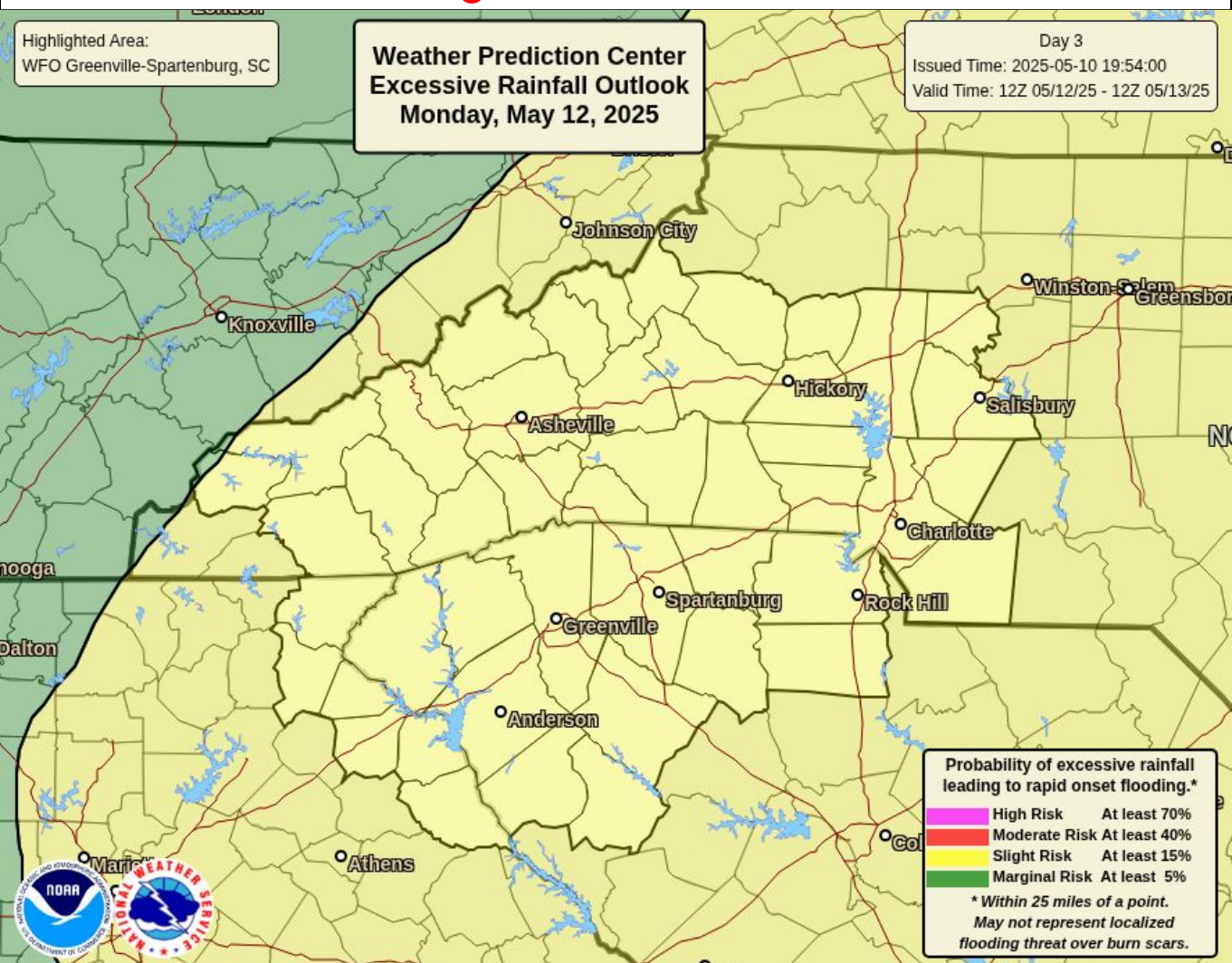
Excessive Rainfall Possible Sunday into Tuesday

May 10, 2025

For the Western Carolinas and Northeast Georgia

OVERVIEW

A prolonged period of heavy rainfall is expected Sunday night through Tuesday across most of the area. **However, this event will NOT produce flooding anywhere near the magnitude of Helene.**



TIMING

- The heaviest rainfall rates/amounts are expected Sunday night into Tuesday.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Some isolated areas of nuisance to minor flooding are possible.
- Nuisance flooding is possible on mainstem rivers including the French Broad, Saluda, Broad, and South Yadkin Rivers. Minor flooding is possible on the South Fork Catawba River. High flows into the Catawba River system are likely.
- **Rainfall amounts can be found on slide 2.**

NWS ALERTS

- None at this time.

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- If the low lingers over the area longer and/or if the environment ends up being more unstable then rainfall rates/amounts may increase.

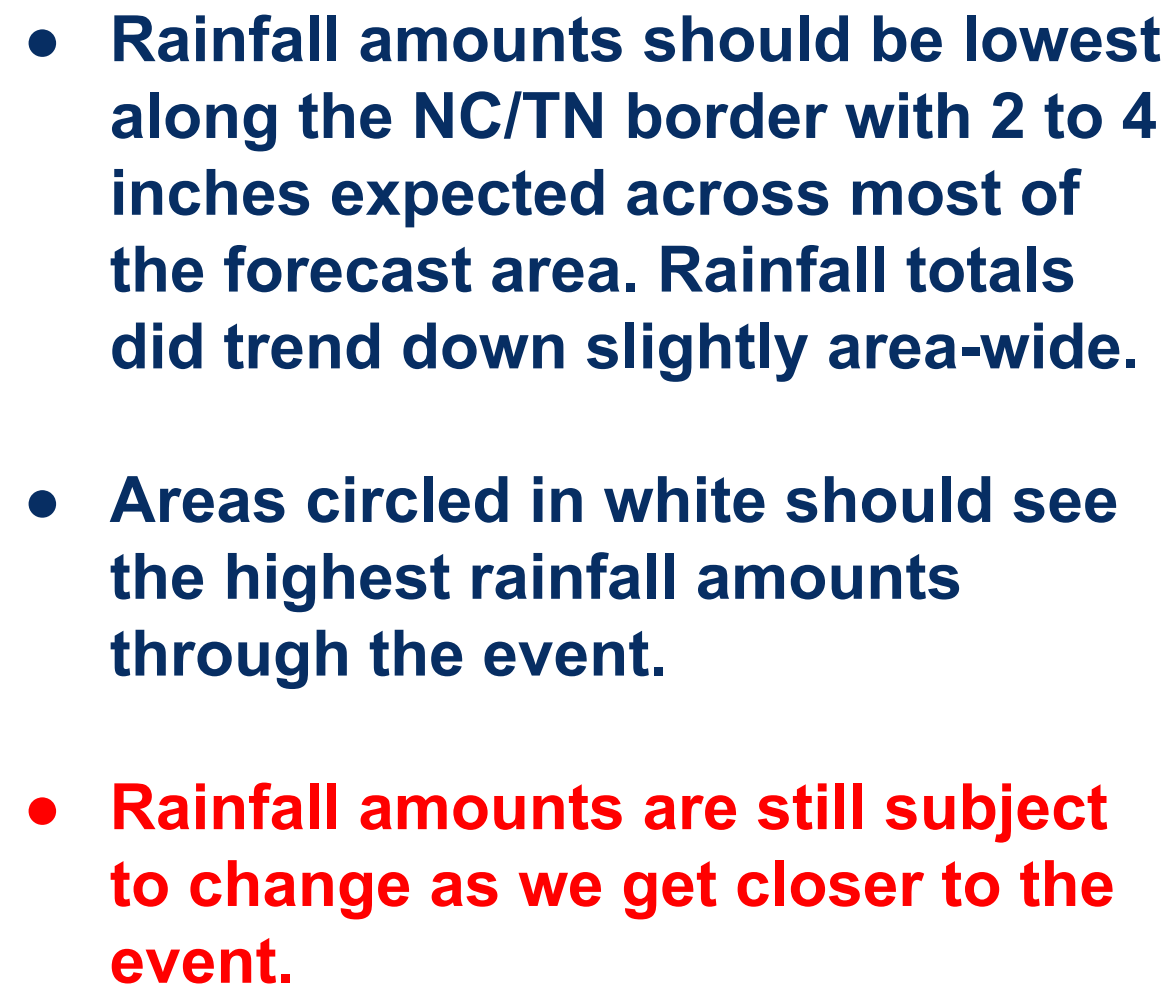
