


# Excessive Rainfall Possible Sunday into Tuesday

For the Western Carolinas and Northeast Georgia



A prolonged period of heavy rainfall is expected Sunday night through Tuesday across most of the area. However, this event will <a href="NOT">NOT</a> produce flooding anywhere near the magnitude of Helene.



### TIMING

 The heaviest rainfall rates/amounts are expected Sunday night into Tuesday.

### HAZARDS & IMPACTS

Some isolated areas of nuisance to minor flooding are

- Nuisance flooding is possible on mainstem rivers including the French Broad, Saluda, Broad, and South Yadkin Rivers. Minor flooding is possible on the South Fork Catawba River. High flows into the Catawba River system are likely.

#### FORECAST CHALLENGES

• If the low lingers over the area longer and/or if the environment ends up being more unstable then rainfall rates/amounts may increase.



## **Storm Total Rainfall**

**Sunday through Tuesday** 



- Rainfall amounts should be lowest along the NC/TN border with 2 to 4 inches expected across most of the forecast area. Rainfall totals did trend down slightly area-wide.
- Areas circled in white should see the highest rainfall amounts through the event.
- Rainfall amounts are still subject to change as we get closer to the event.
