



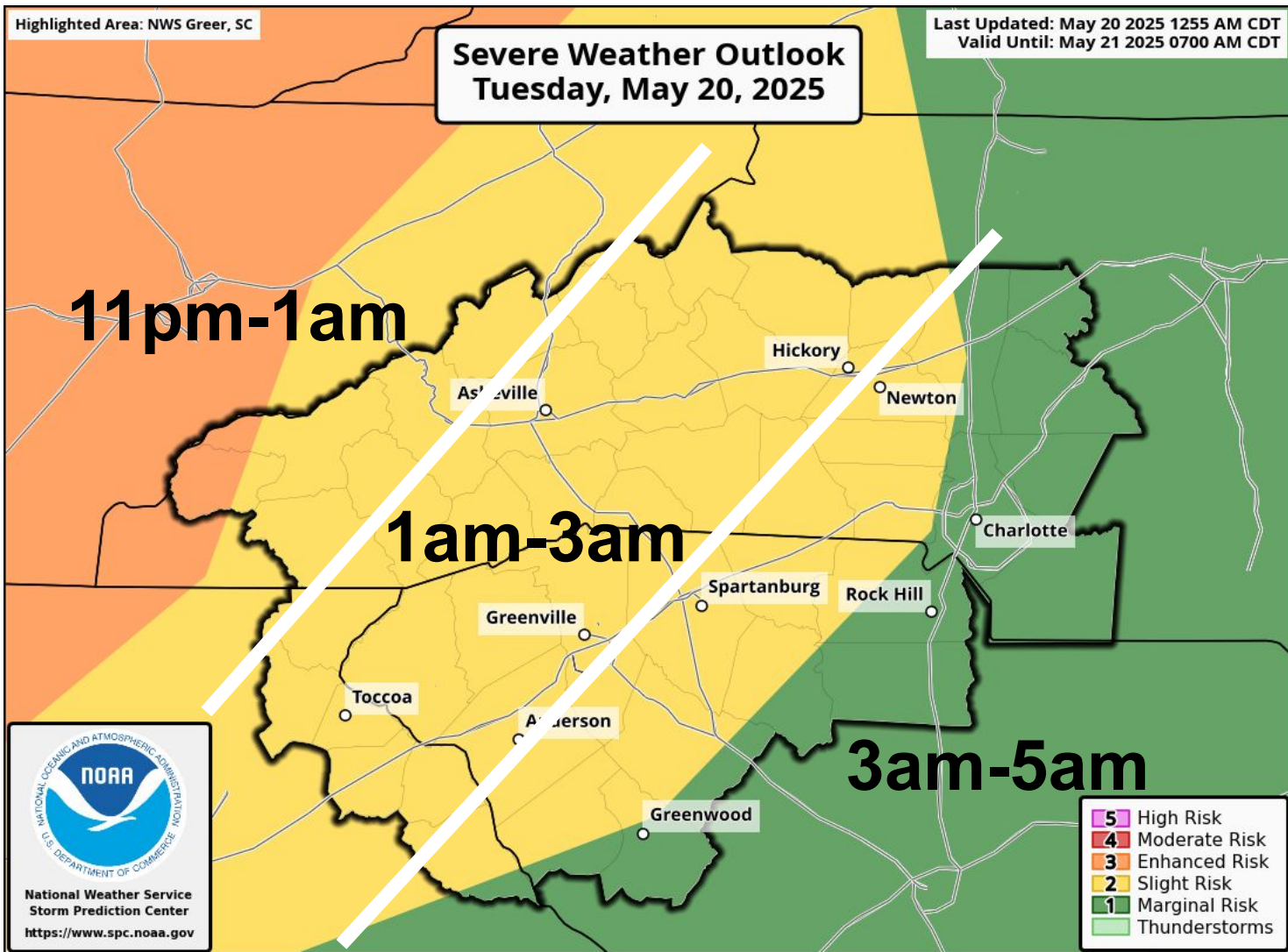
Severe Storms Possible Tuesday Night

May 20, 2025

For the Western Carolinas and Northeast Georgia

OVERVIEW

A few strong to severe storms are possible tonight across parts of the area.



TIMING

- 11pm-1am in the far western zones
- 1am-3am east of the mountains
- **Not all sites will see a storm**

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Damaging wind gusts
- Large hail
- A few isolated tornadoes (see slide #2)

NWS ALERTS

None at this time.

FORECAST CHALLENGES

Storms that do cross the mountains are coming in well after peak heating and the better instability remains ahead of the storms. How much weakening occurs to these storms from the mountains still remains a factor in how these storms evolve.

POST-EVENT OUTLOOK

Cold front passes bringing drier air and cooler temperatures.

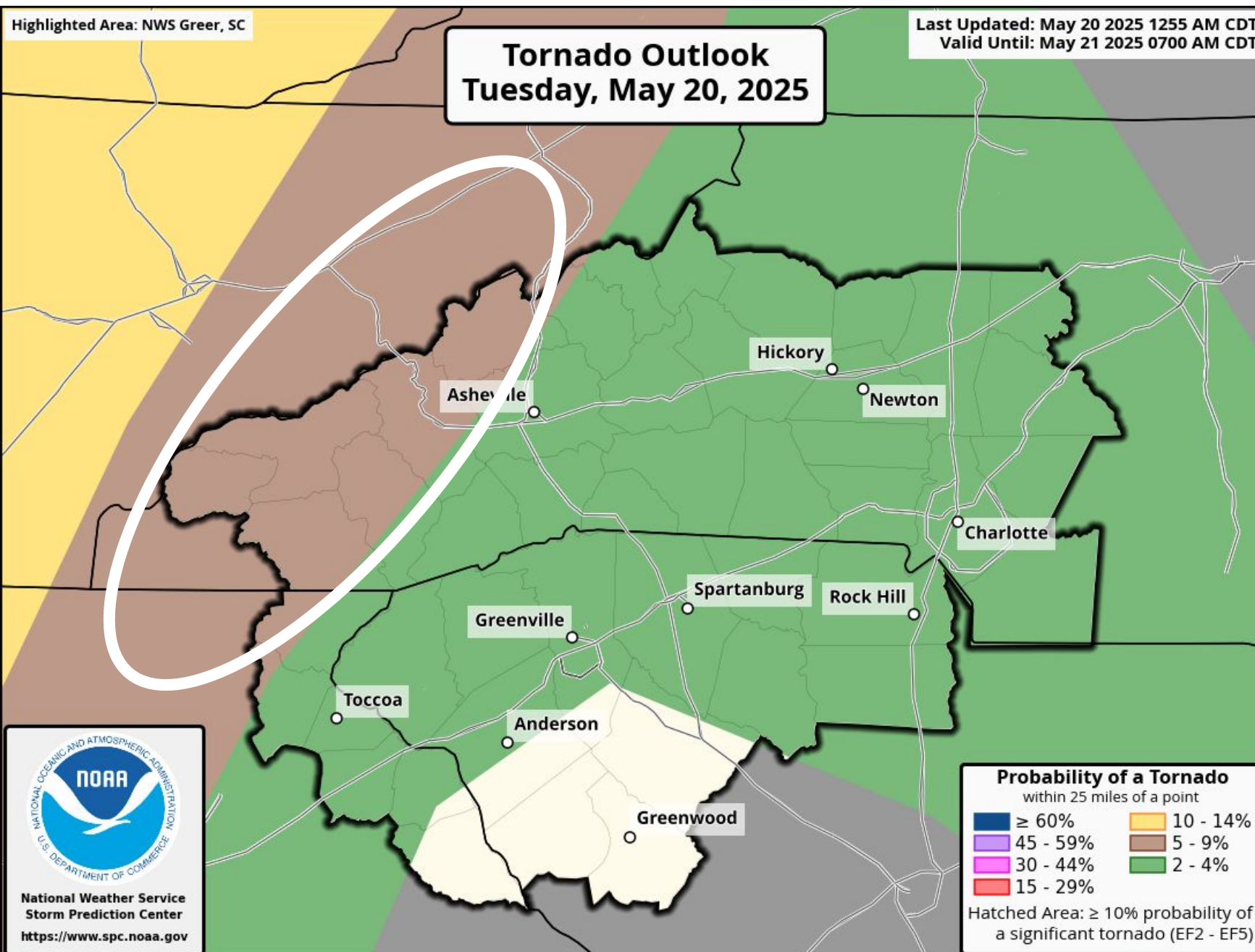




Tornado Risk for Tuesday Night

Though general weakening of storms is likely, a few isolated, brief tornadoes cannot be ruled out. The highest potential for tornadoes is across the western zones (white circle).
