



# Severe Thunderstorms Possible Today

May 30, 2025

For the western Carolinas and northeast Georgia

## OVERVIEW

A cold front brings a higher threat for strong-to-severe storms as it crosses the area from late this morning through the afternoon.

### TIMING

- The main line of thunderstorms reaches the NC mountains between 11AM and 2PM Friday.
- The line of thunderstorms is expected to reach along and south and east of the I-85 corridor around 1PM to 4PM and continue eastward.

### HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Damaging wind gusts downing trees and power lines, and causing minor structural damage.
- Large hail is possible but not as high of a risk.
- A couple of brief tornadoes are possible this afternoon, especially east of the mountains.
- Localized nuisance/minor flooding, mainly in urban areas and other locations with poor drainage.

### FORECAST CHALLENGES

- Some uncertainty remains with the timing of the front and these hazards could play out. Slightly slower timing could result in some increase in the severe weather threat for the mountains. The threat remains the same elsewhere.

### POST-EVENT OUTLOOK

- Afternoon showers are possible Saturday and Sunday, mainly in the mountains, near the Tennessee border.
