


Severe Storms Possible Friday and Saturday

OVERVIEW

Severe storms are possible on Friday (level 1 of 5 threat) with a better chance of severe storms on Saturday (level 2 of 5 threat). **See page 2 for Saturday's Severe risk.**



TIMING

- During the afternoon and evening hours each day.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Damaging wind gusts are the primary threat with any severe storms that develop each day.
- Large hail possible.

NWS ALERTS

- None at this time.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Confidence is lower on the severe threat on Friday compared to Saturday as Saturday looks like the better day to see strong to severe storms develop.

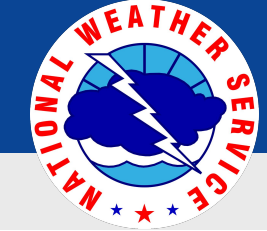
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK

- The pattern remains unsettled Sunday through the middle of next week. Strong to severe storms are possible each afternoon and evening.



