



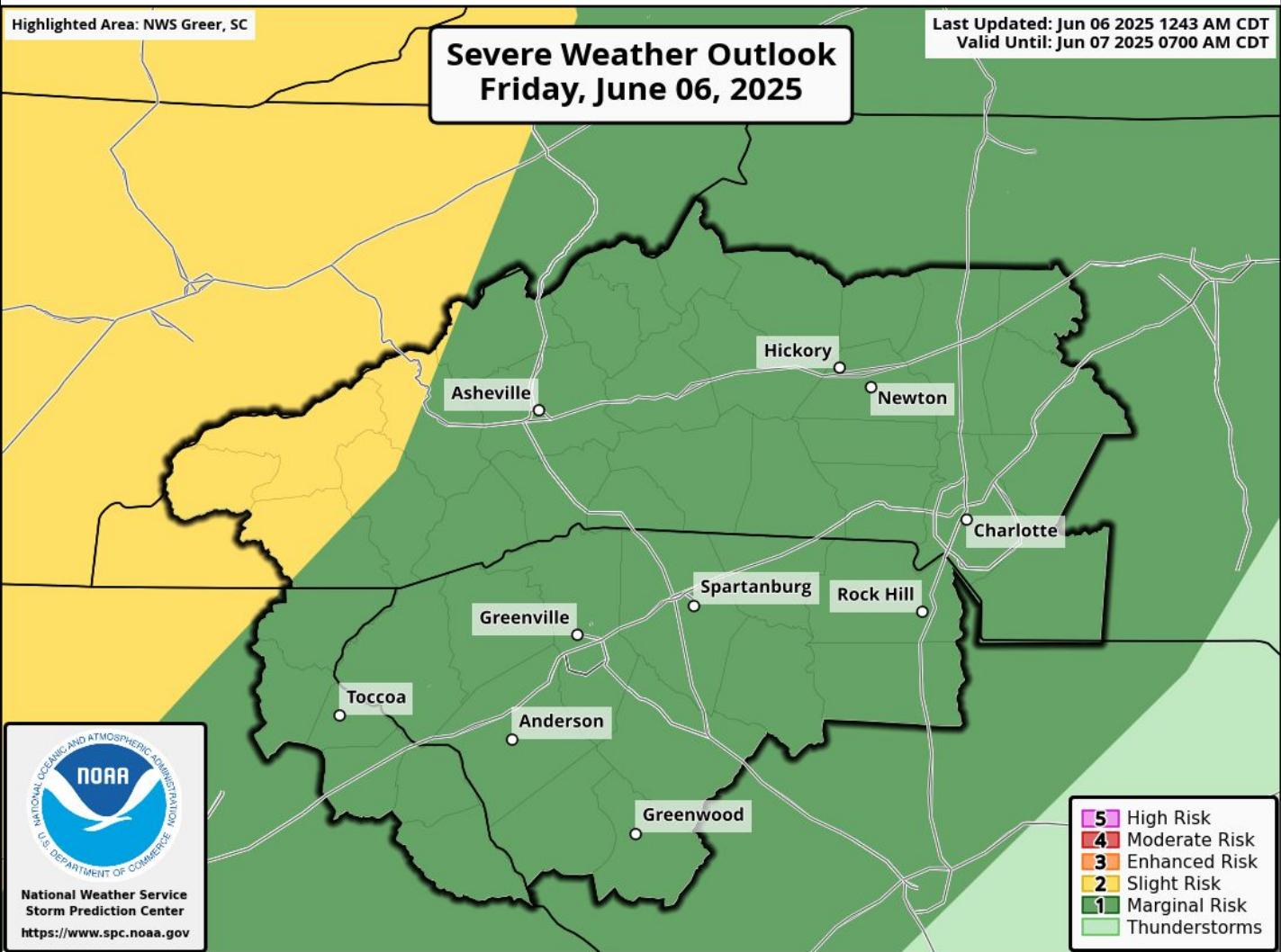
Severe Storms Possible Today and Saturday

June 6, 2025

For the Western Carolinas and Northeast Georgia

OVERVIEW

Severe storms are possible today (level 1 of 5 threat) with a better chance of severe storms on Saturday (level 2 of 5 threat). **See page 2 for Saturday's Severe risk.**



TIMING

- During the afternoon and evening hours each day.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Damaging wind gusts are the primary threat with any severe storms that develop each day.
- Isolated large hail possible.

NWS ALERTS

- None at this time.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The severe weather threat both today and Saturday is conditional. Any storms that develop will have the potential to be severe, but confidence as to when/where any storms form is below average.

POST-EVENT OUTLOOK

- The pattern remains unsettled Sunday through the middle of next week. Strong to severe storms are possible each afternoon and evening.

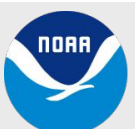
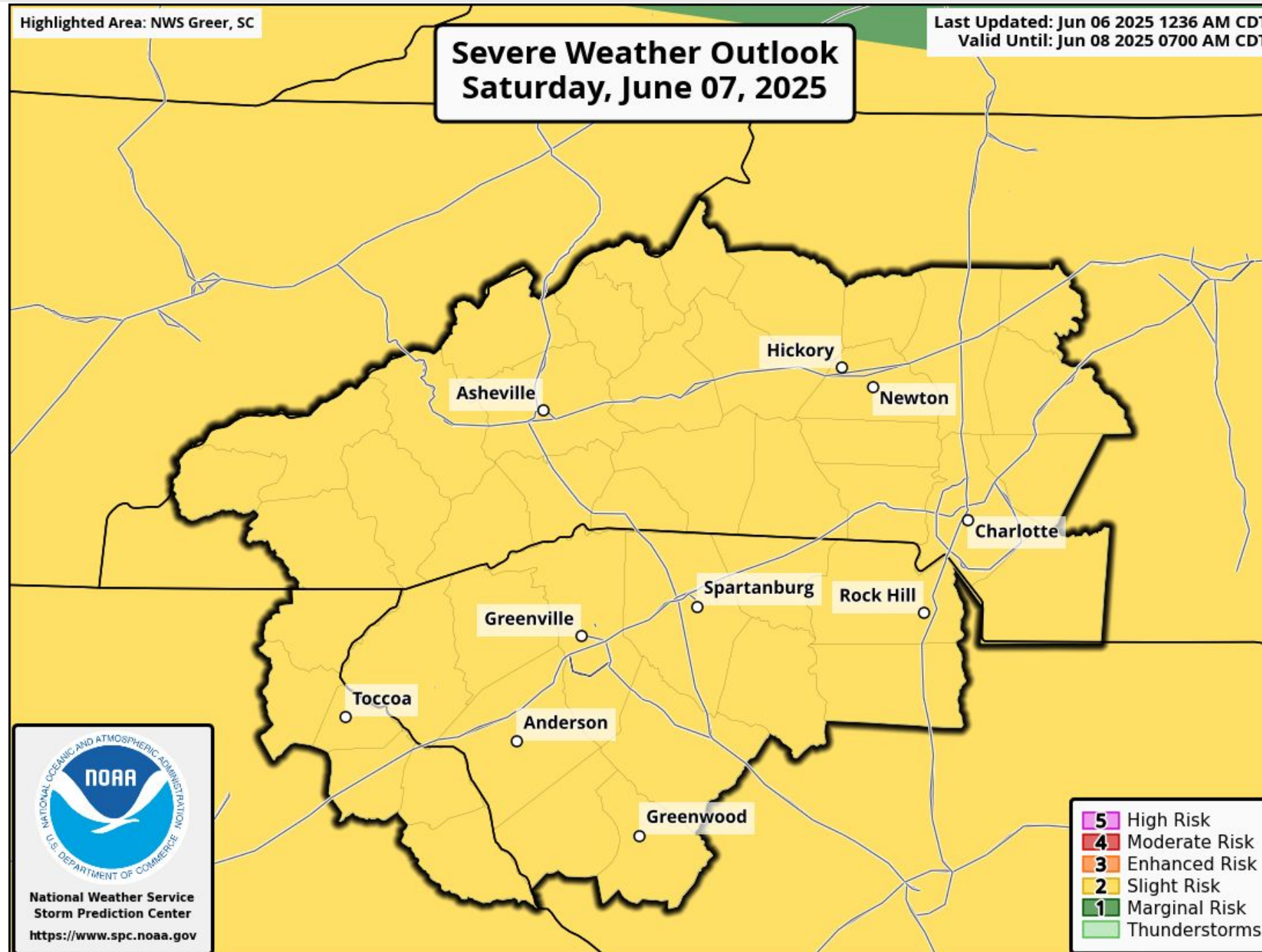
