



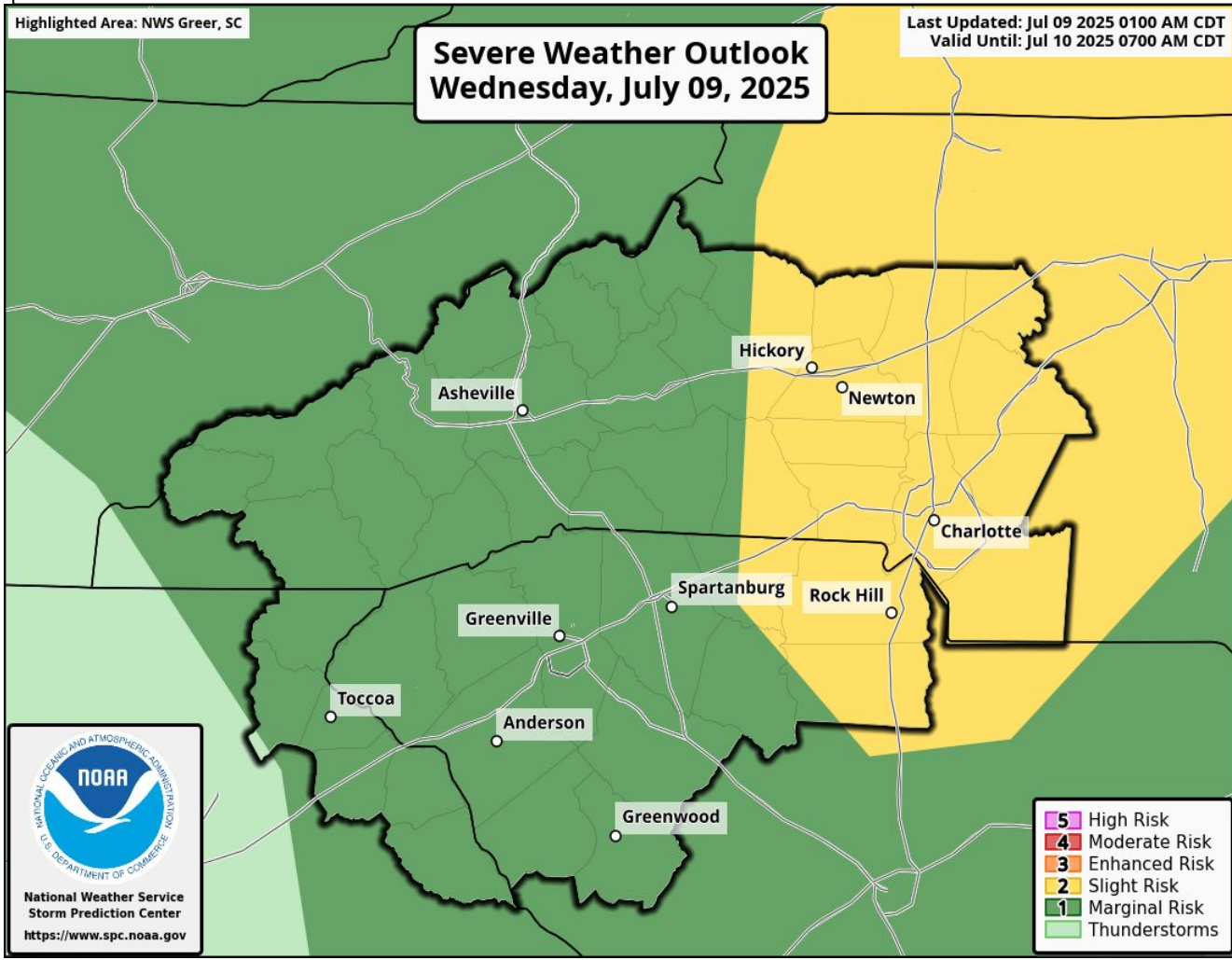
Severe Storms & Localized Flooding Possible Today

July 9, 2025
5:42 AM

For the western Carolinas and northeast Georgia

OVERVIEW

- Strong to severe thunderstorms will be possible this afternoon and evening.
- Excessive rainfall from some of these storms could produce localized flooding (see slide 2 for flooding threat).



TIMING

- Storms are expected to develop over the NC mountains this afternoon and then spread eastward and southward.
- Some storms could linger thru the late evening hours, especially over our eastern zones.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Damaging wind gusts are the main hazard with any severe storms that develop. Isolated large hail cannot be ruled out.
- In addition, storms will be capable of producing heavy downpours that may lead to localized flash flooding, especially over areas that receive multiple rounds of rain.

NWS ALERTS

- None at this time.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The active pattern will continue thru the end of the week, with strong to severe thunderstorms and localized flooding possible each day.

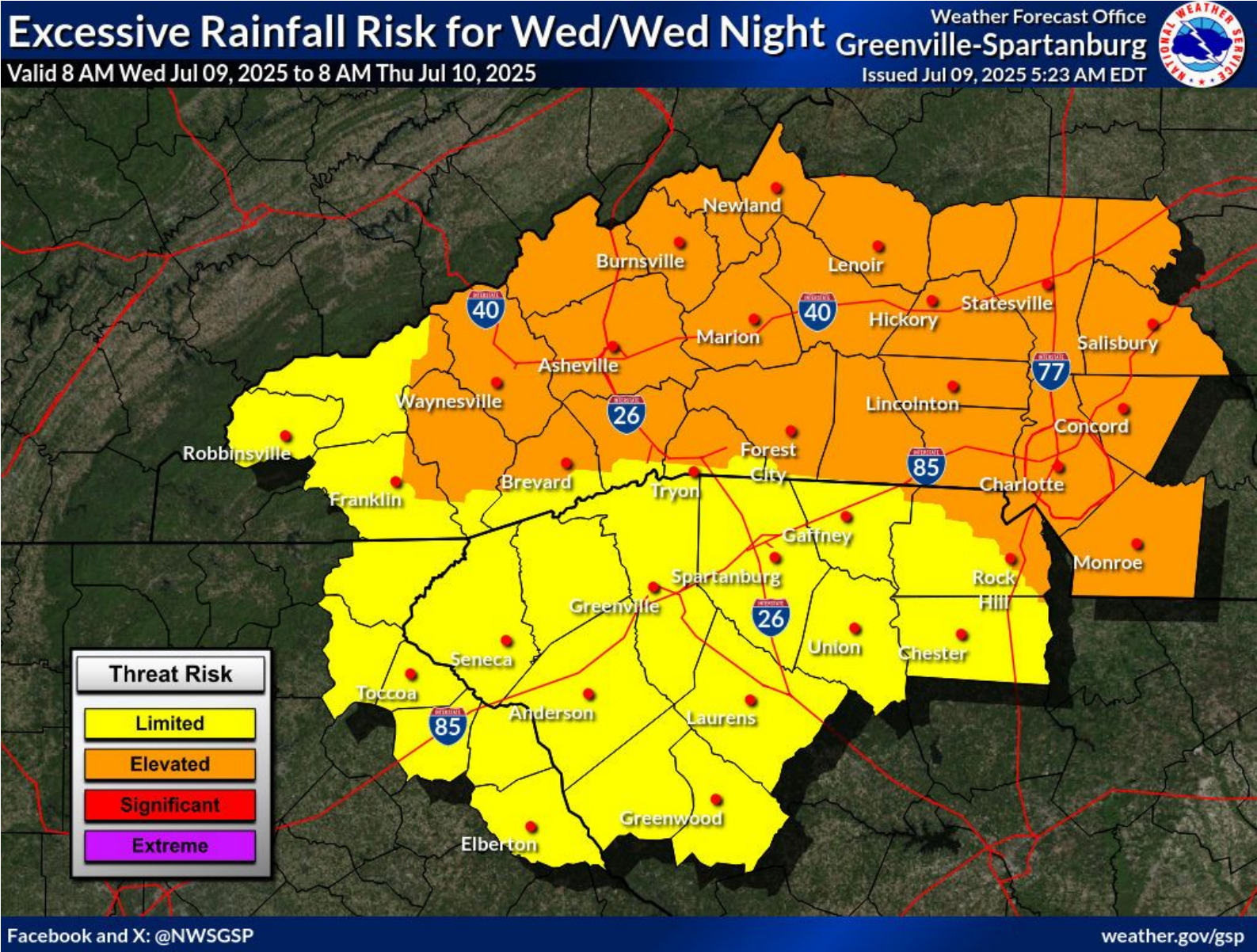
