


Severe Storms Possible through Friday

For the Western Carolinas and Northeast Georgia

OVERVIEW

Strong to severe thunderstorms are possible each afternoon and evening through Friday. See slide 2 for the severe threat on Friday & Saturday.



TIMING

• Each afternoon and evening.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

 Damaging wind gusts are the main hazard with any severe storms that develop. However, locally heavy rainfall may result in localized flash flooding, especially over areas that receive multiple rounds of rain.

NWS ALERTS

None at this time.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

 Although we can expect more showers and thunderstorms on Saturday, strong to severe thunderstorms appear less likely over the weekend.
