TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Temperatures in the upper 90s and lower 100s are expected each afternoon beginning Saturday...with the hottest and muggiest conditions expected Sunday through Tuesday.▪ Temperatures will subside overnight, but relief will be limited as lows only fall into the 70s.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Excessive heat and humidity will lead to oppressive heat index values as high as 108°.▪ Heat will affect anyone without access to air conditioning and easy access to water.▪ Impacts are likely in some health systems and heat-sensitive industries (outdoor workers).
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ None at this time. Heat Advisories may eventually be needed east of the North Carolina mountains.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Confidence on the dewpoint forecast remains limited, which makes for uncertainty in the heat index forecast.▪ Heat index could trend lower, but with higher confidence on temperatures in the low 100s, impacts are nonetheless expected.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ A cooldown is expected at the end of the week, with afternoon temperatures significantly cooler beginning on Friday.
