Effective today, November 24th, 2025, at 12:00pm, the Mitchell County Fire Marshal's Office rescinds the burn ban that was put into effect for all of Mitchell County on November 18th, 2025.

Keeping the citizens of Mitchell County safe is the main focus of the Mitchell County Fire Marshal's Office. As atmospheric conditions continue to improve, the risk of wildfires at the current time is declining.

If you can wait to burn, please do so. If you decide to legally burn on your property, the Mitchell County Fire Marshal's Office encourages you to use safe burning practices, to burn only natural vegetation, and to always obtain a burning permit through the NCFS.
