Key Messages

- Winter Weather Advisory in effect from **1 AM tonight through 1 AM Tuesday** for:

Avery County

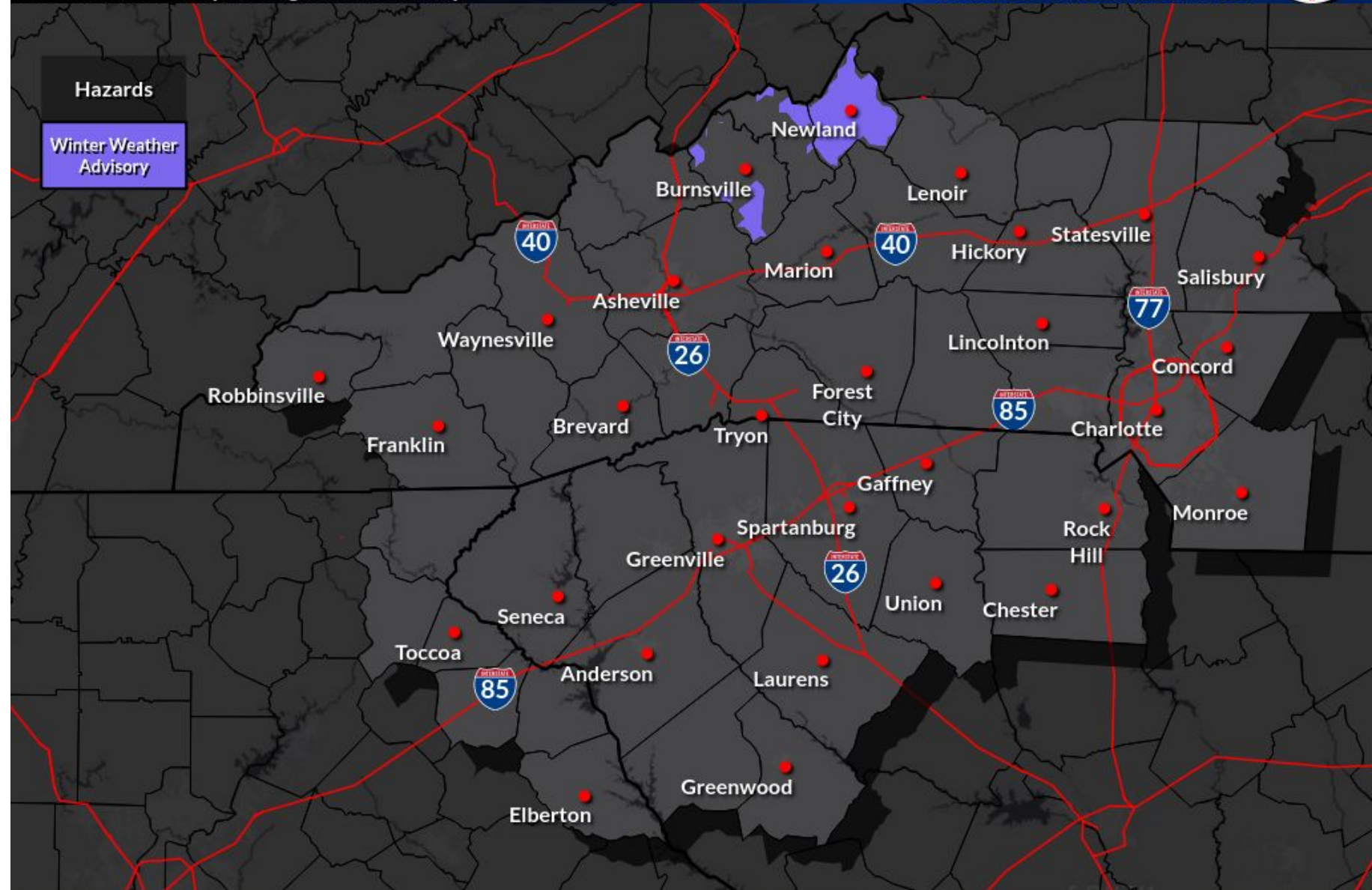
Mitchell and Yancey Counties above 3500"

- 1-3 inches of snow possible in the advisory areas. Outside the advisory, anywhere from a trace up to 2 inches is possible in the mountains, especially above 3500".
- Timing of precipitation begins after **1AM in the mountains** with a cold rain **east of the mountains after 7AM**.

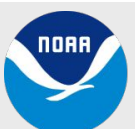

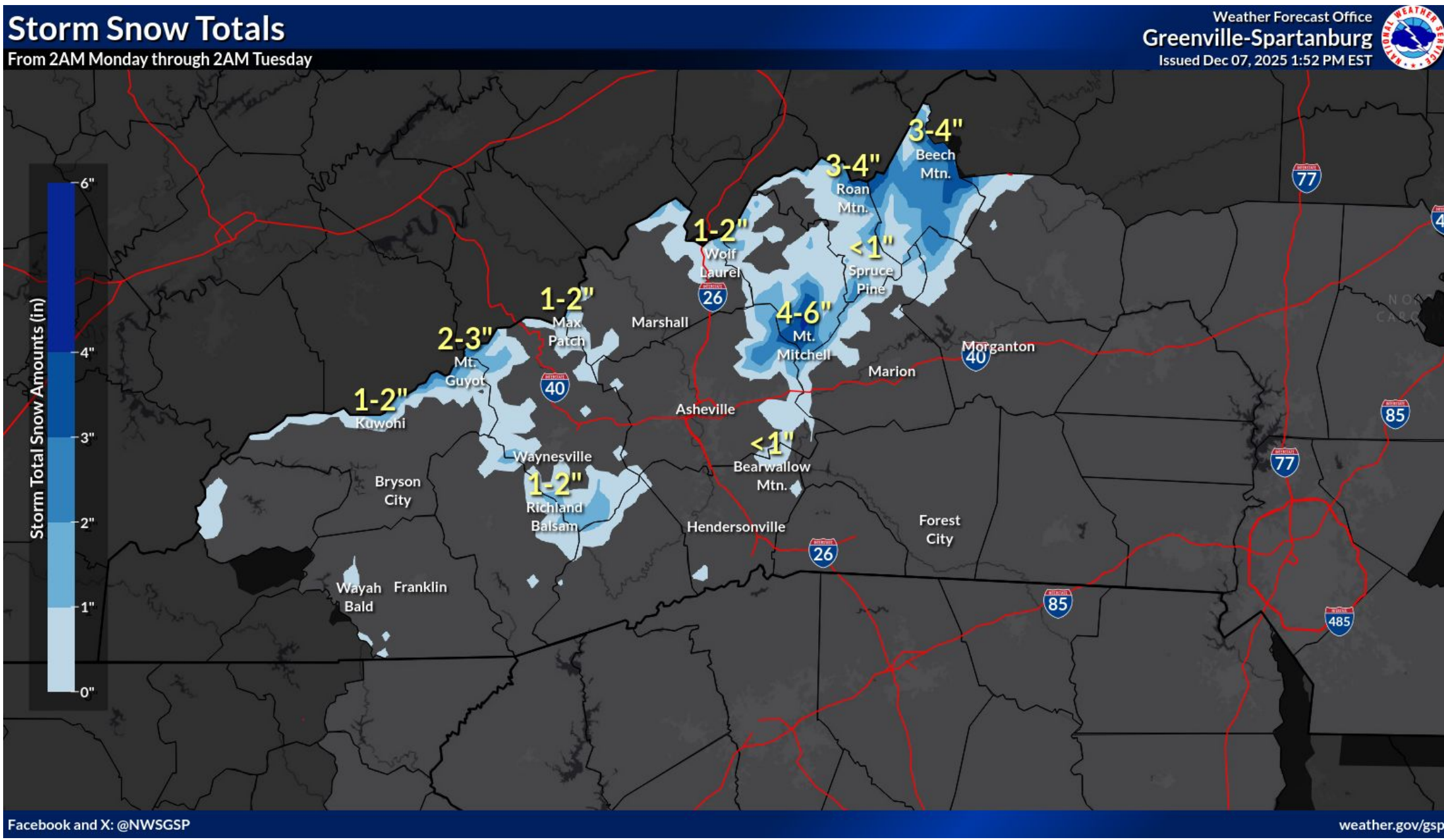
Storm Snow Totals for Monday

December 7, 2025

For the Western Carolina Mountains

For Avery County: 1-3 inches likely with locally higher amounts up to 4 inches possible at the higher elevations.

Cold wet rain is expected outside the mountains but a brief wintry mix of snow/rain is possible along and north of I-40. **Snow accumulations at this time are not expected.**
