
For Western North Carolina

Key Messages

 Winter Weather Advisory remains in effect through 1 AM Tuesday for:

Avery County Mitchell and Yancey Counties above 3500'

- 1-4 inches of snow possible in the advisory areas, with some ridgetops above 5000 feet getting up to 5 inches.
- Outside the advisory, anywhere from a trace up to 2 inches is possible in the mountains, especially above 3500 feet.
- The precipitation should taper off in early/mid afternoon east of the mountains, and during late afternoon/early evening over the mountains.







Storm Total Snowfall Today

For the North Carolina Mountains

For Avery County and Mitchell/Yancey counties above 3500 feet: 1-4 inches likely with locally higher amounts up to 5 inches possible at the higher elevations.

Cold rain is expected outside the mountains but a brief wintry mix of snow/rain is possible along and north of I-40, where accumulations of less than an inch are expected.
