## Winter Weather Through Tonight


For Western North Carolina

### **Key Messages**

 Winter Weather Advisory remains in effect through 1 AM Tuesday for:

# **Avery County Mitchell and Yancey Counties above 3500'**

- A few locations above 3500' could receive an additional 1-2 inches of snow from now through 1 AM Tuesday.
- The precipitation should taper off at the higher elevations between 10PM - 1AM tonight.






# **Additional Snow Totals Tonight**

For the North Carolina Mountains

For locations along the NC/TN border, mainly above 3500"- An additional 1-2 inches is possible as weak NW flow sets up through the evening.

Temperatures are expected to drop well below freezing in the mountains, causing ice to form on wet roadways and create slippery road conditions overnight and into the morning hours.

\*\*Temps should rise above freezing after 11AM Tuesday\*\*.
