

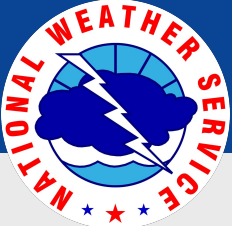
Key Messages

- Wind Advisory issued for Avery County and for elevations above 3500 feet in NC mountain counties (except Henderson), valid from 10 am today through 10 am Thursday.
- Winter Weather Advisory issued for Avery County and elevations above 3500 feet in Madison, Yancey, and Mitchell Counties from 1 pm today through 10 am Thursday.

Storm Total Snow Accumulation

December 10, 2025
4:58 AM

For This Afternoon Through Early Thursday Morning

Hazard Details

- Light rain will change over to light snow late this afternoon and early this evening. Snow will taper off around daybreak on Thursday.
- Snow accumulations of 2-4 inches are expected at the high elevations near the TN border of Madison, Yancey, Mitchell and Avery counties, but generally an inch or less is expected over eastern parts of those counties.
- Strong winds could cause blowing snow that would greatly reduce visibility at times late tonight.

Peak Wind Gusts Through Tonight

4:58 AM EST


Hazard Details

- Winds will increase starting around 10 am today and will continue through tonight.
- Wind gusts will occasionally reach 45-50 mph at elevations above 3500 feet across the mountains of North Carolina.
- Strong winds could knock down some tree limbs and power lines, resulting in power outages.
- Wind gusts east of the mountains could reach 30-35 mph at times mainly this afternoon.

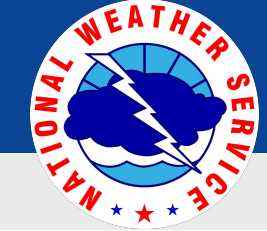
