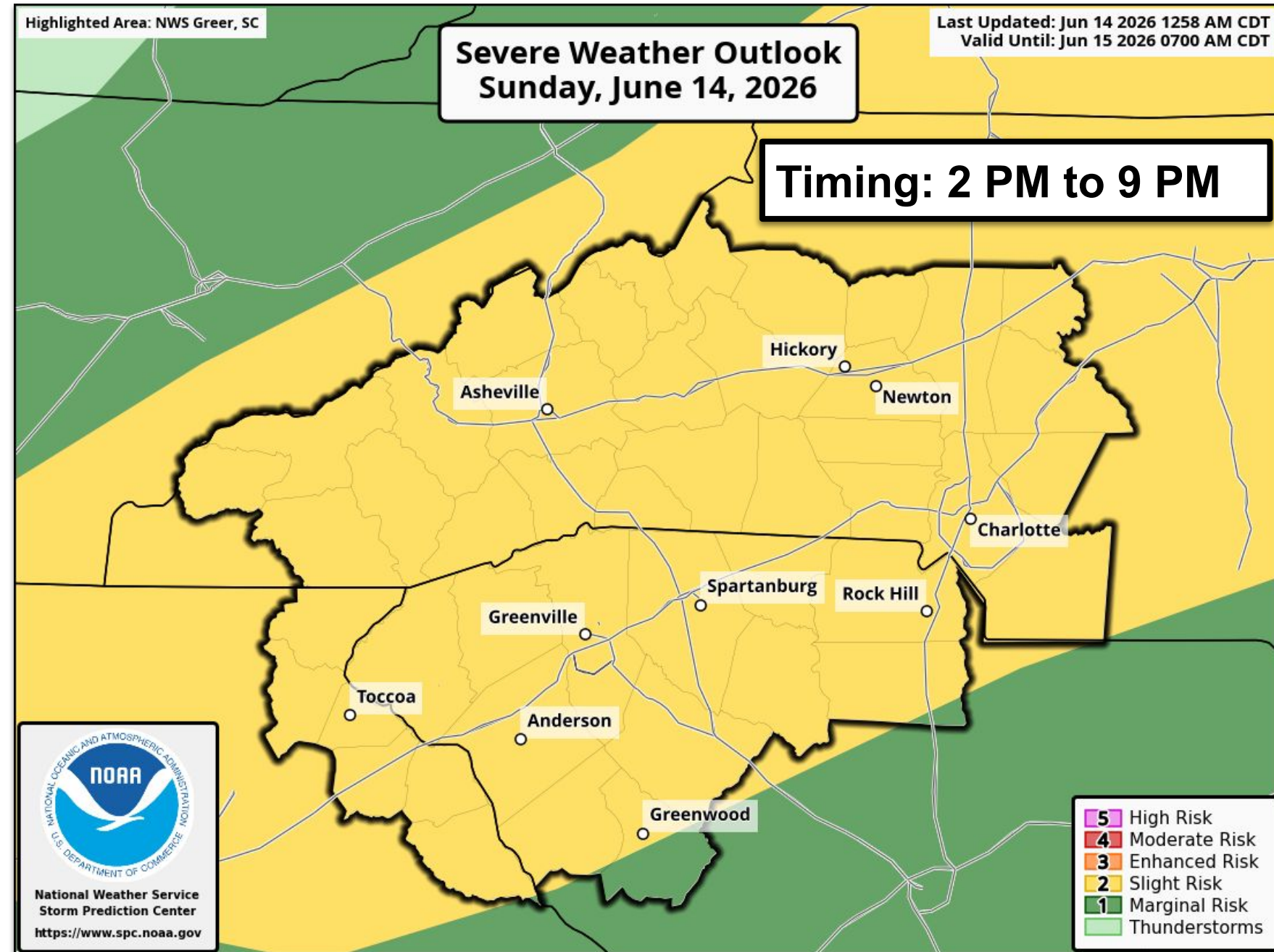
## NEW Important Updates

→ Strong to severe storms are possible **this afternoon and evening** across the western Carolinas and northeast Georgia.

→ **Damaging winds** are the main hazard with any severe storms that develop.





# Damaging Wind Threat Today

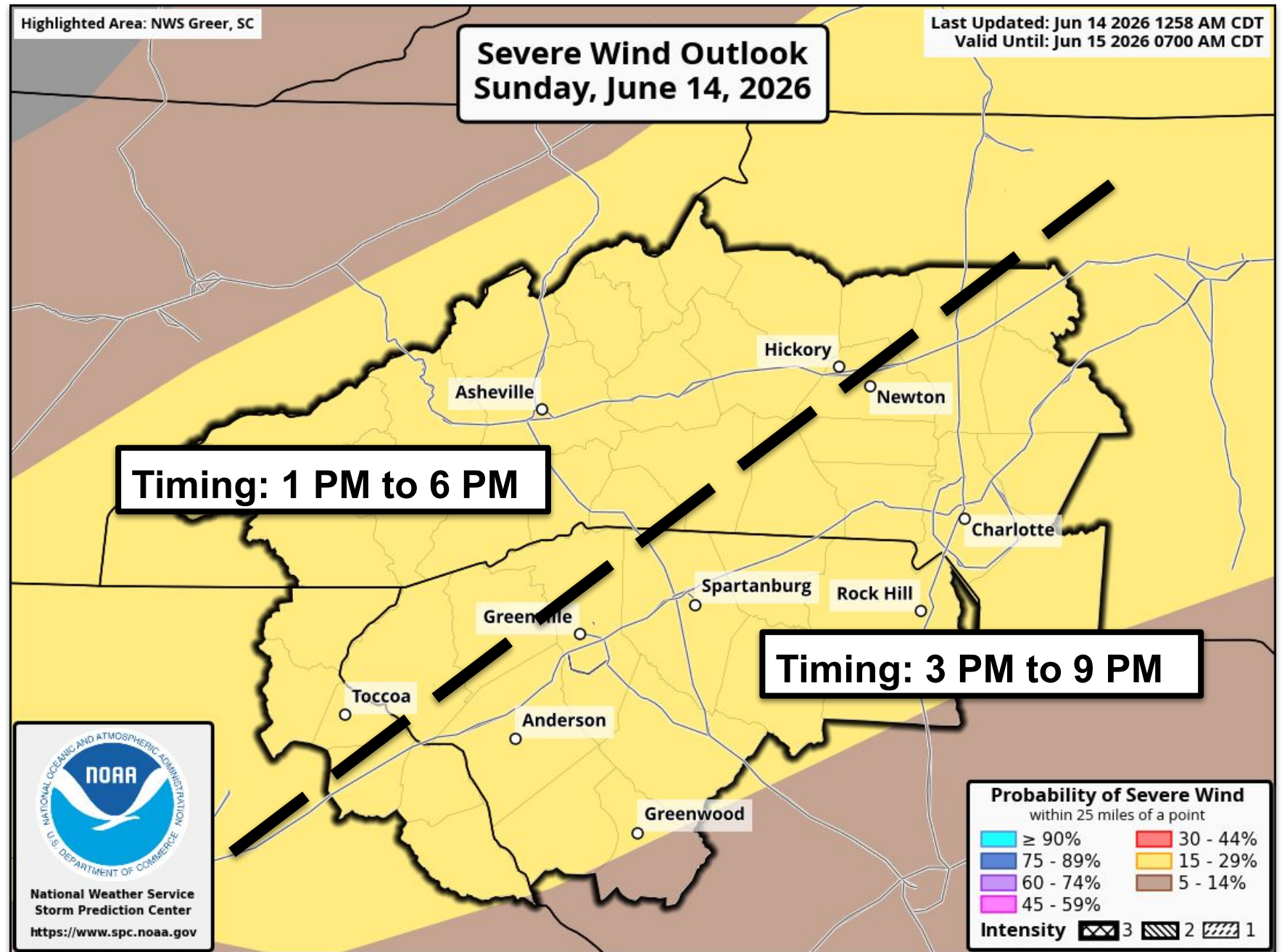
