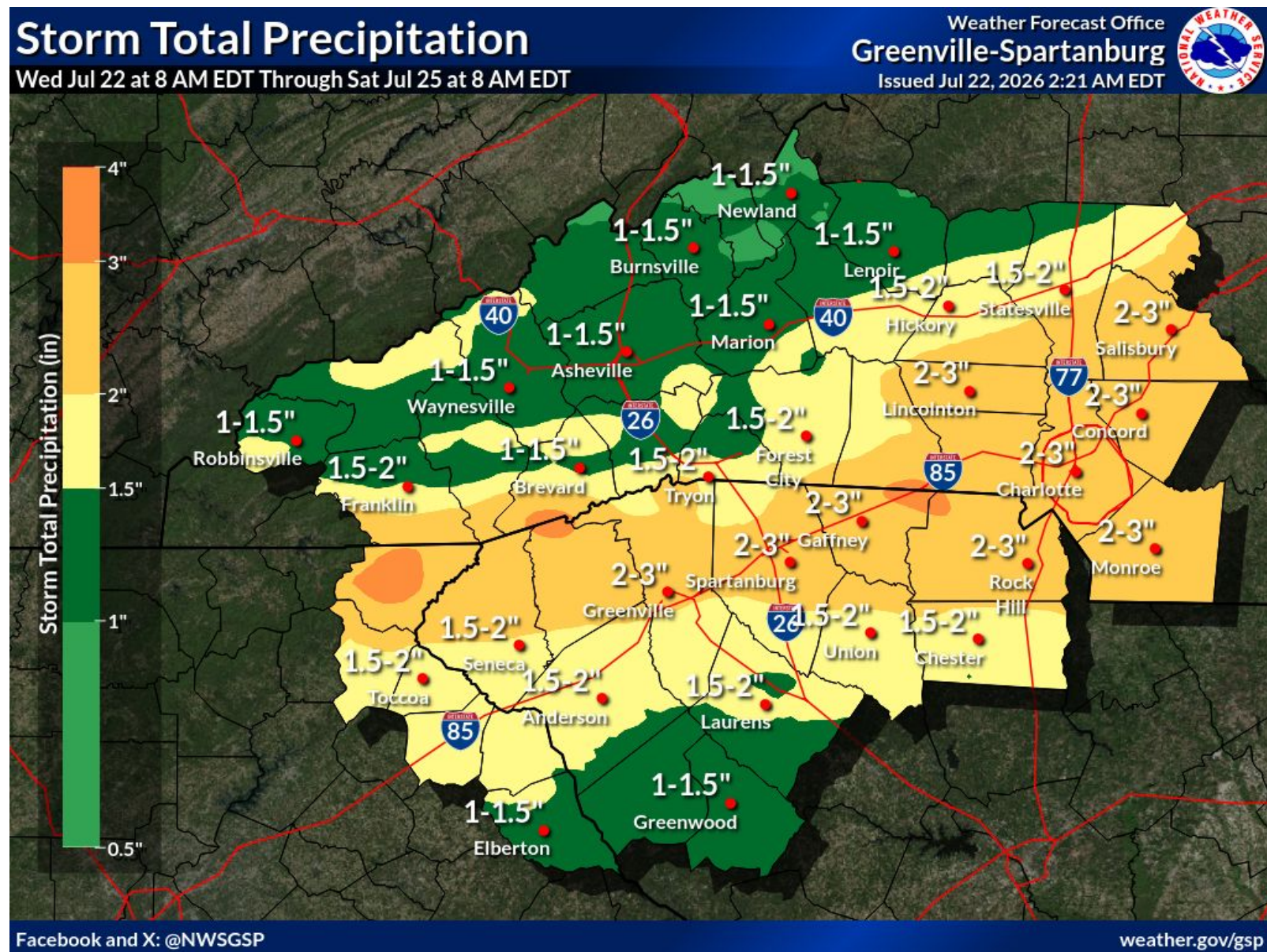

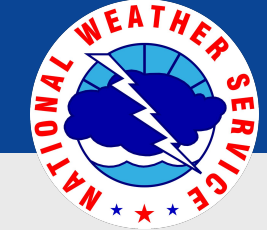
Key Messages

- Multiple rounds of thunderstorms will lead to some heavy rainfall and potentially isolated flooding today through Friday.
- A few thunderstorms could become severe this afternoon with damaging wind gusts the main threat.
- The graphic to the right is the forecast Storm Total Precipitation today through Friday night.

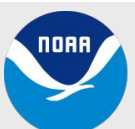
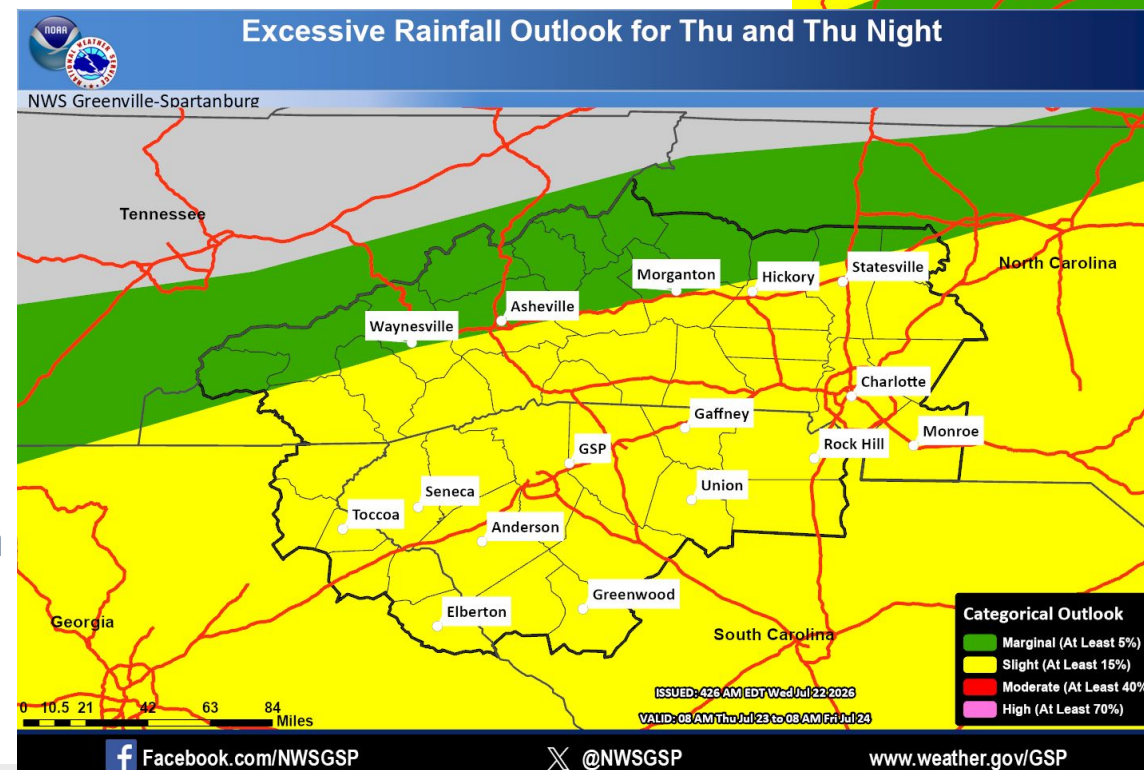
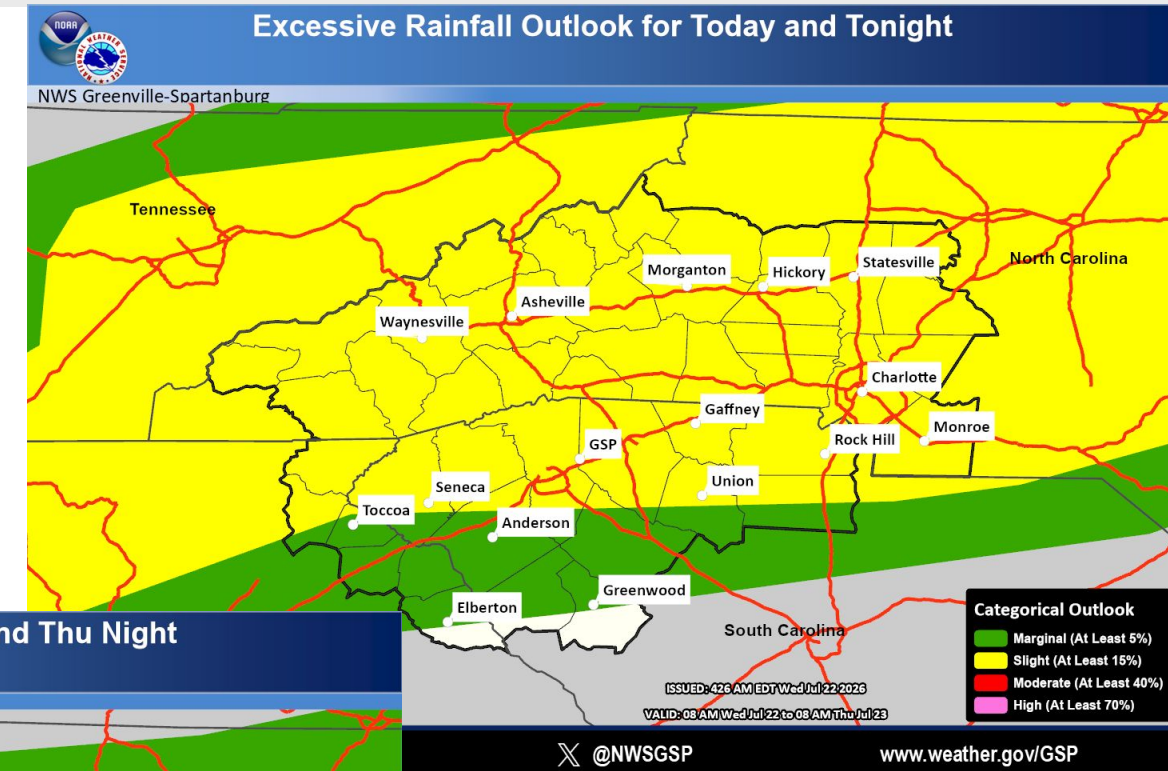
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Several Rounds of Thunderstorms May Lead to Isolated Flooding

Hazard Details

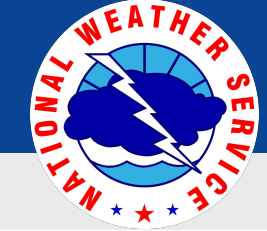
- Several rounds of thunderstorms will lead to heavy rainfall and may lead to isolated flooding.
- No Flood Watch is in effect for the NWS Greenville-Spartanburg, SC forecast area at this time.
- Thunderstorm coverage ramps up this afternoon and continues into the evening.
- More thunderstorms develop Friday afternoon and continue into the evening.
- Forecast models differ on the amount of precipitation and location of the heaviest rainfall. If confidence increases on the amounts and locations, then a Flood Watch would be issued.



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Isolated Severe Thunderstorms Possible

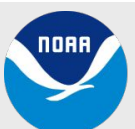
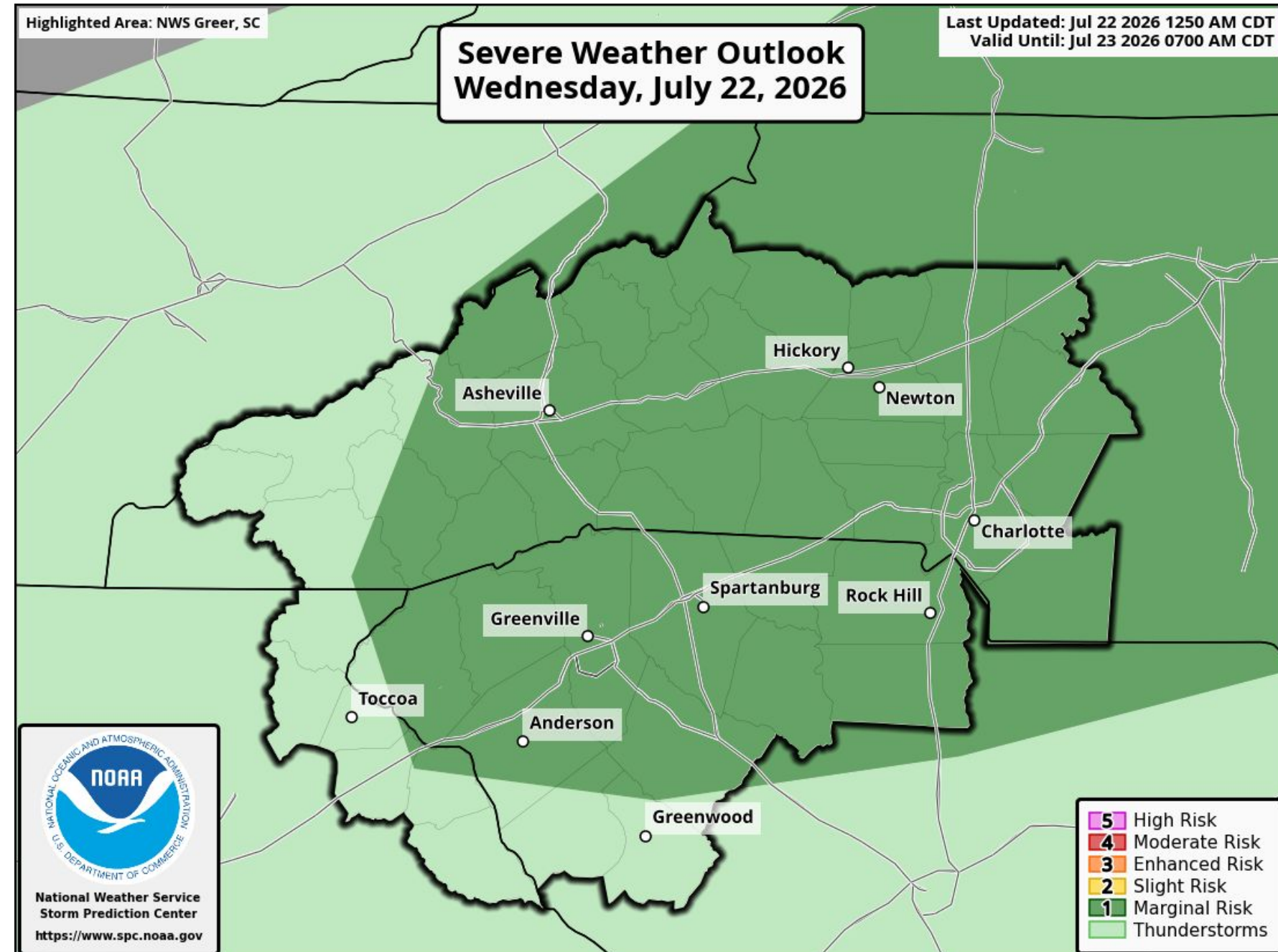
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Damaging Wind Gusts The Main Threat
