This year Marshall County is scheduled to camp from Monday, June 22nd to Thursday, June 25th at West Kentucky 4-H Camp in Dawson Springs, KY.

We will be camping with friends from Ballard, Fulton, Graves, Carlisle and Calloway Counties.

The total cost for camp is just \$175 for the first 75 campers signed up by May 1st! After the first 75 campers/May 1st, the cost per camper increases to \$250 so register ASAP.

WHY? *IT'S FUN! IT'S EDUCATIONAL!* 4-H Camp gives you the opportunity to participate in activities such as boating, horseback riding, sports, swimming, rifle, archery, arts and crafts, and many more exciting events.

HOW? *RETURNING THE REGISTRATION FORM!* The cost of 4-H Camp this year is \$250. You still have time to sign up, but there is a limited number of Marshall County 9-14 year olds that can go, because of the spaces available at camp. So don't delay! If you are able but it is not required as of 3/26/2020, you can include a \$50 payment with the registration form. The payment will be applied to the camper's overall fee.

The cost of camp this year is \$250.
