##### REGISTRATION APPOINTMENT:

- **Child's Certified Birth Certificate**
- **Proof of all applicable income & benefits received in 2020:**
  - 1040 Tax Return ,all W-2s, current check stub
  - Unemployment benefits
  - Proof of Child Support in 2020 (including siblings)
  - K-TAP, Social Security, Disability, SSI
  - 2020 school grants or scholarships (1098 Form)
  - SNAP letter with case number
- Child's Social Security Card
- Child's Medical Health Insurance Card
- Custody Papers (if applicable)

**Incomplete applications will delay enrollment process.**

Transportation services may be provided for Preschool/Head Start families by request. Head Start staff will assist families to understand and access transportation options in order to participate in Head Start program activities.
