## **EXECUTIVE ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, Marshall County hereby is experiencing drought conditions which may lead to extra ordinary fire hazards; and

WHEREAS, Wood/brush fires quickly exhaust the firefighting resources of the county; and

WHEREAS, weather forecasts indicate a prolonged dry period with no expected significant precipitation; and

**WHEREAS**, these conditions endanger the public health and safety and threaten the natural resources of the Commonwealth; and

**NOW THEREFORE,** I, Kevin Spraggs, Marshall County Judge/Executive, by the virtue of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, do hereby order and direct the following:

- 1. All burning within the County is prohibited.
- 2. All local law enforcement personnel shall enforce this Executive Order per KRS 39A.180.
- 3. Any person who violates the ban established in this Executive Order shall be subject to penalties provided under KRS 39A.90, and such penalties under state law.
- 4. This Order shall become effective Tuesday, March 11, 2025 and remain in effect until further ordered.

A copy of this Executive Order will be released to media outlets and local emergency response agencies.
