7. Supplemental Recruitment Initiatives

(a) Initiative: Participation in Job Fairs

(b) Initiative: Management Level EEO Training

On April 25, 2026, the Employment Unit's General Manager attended a seminar sponsored by the West Virginia Broadcasters Association on Sales and Broadcasting where a group discussion took place regarding sales hiring and the requirements of the Federal Communications Commission's Equal Employment Opportunities regulations.

(c) Initiative: Management Level EEO Training

While the employment unit did not host an intern during this reporting period, it hopes to further its internship program during the next reporting cycle.

(g) Initiative: WVU Scholarship Funds
