

# Valdez Police Department 2020 Mid-Year Report

## *Police (January 1 – July 13)*

### ***Dispatch / Corrections (January 1- July 13)***

- Answered 9,866 incoming phone calls – Made 7,201 Outgoing calls
- Answered 123 landline 9-1-1 calls
- Man days in jail: 380
- Man days on Electronic Monitoring: 2,418
- Processed 83 fingerprint cases
- Processed 173 court documents

Four Public Safety Technicians attended the 3 week Municipal Corrections Academy in January. Due to COVID-19 additional training opportunities have either been postponed or cancelled for this year.

### ***Animal Control (January 1 – June 30)***

- Approximately 6350 visitors
- 31 Volunteers, working 23 hours
- 0 hours of Community Service
- 109 Animal Control cases
- 85 Animal calls
- 14 Bear Related calls
- 72 Dogs Licensed
- 69 Cremations performed
- Took in 72 animals (43 surrenders, 21 impounds, 7 Vet assist, 3 protective custody)
- 66 Animals out (33 adopted, 18 returned to owner, 6 died due to medical, 3 euthanized)

### ***Code Enforcement (January 1 - July 13)***

- Assisted COV PIO as part of Unified Command [COVID-19]
- Continued to implement MyGov software, specific to Code Enforcement/Nuisance Abatement
- Administered the Vehicle Abatement Program
  - 71 vehicles slated to be voluntarily removed from Valdez (61 off private property, 10 off of public land)
- 1 Voluntary Compliance Agreements entered into
- Issued 1 Notice and Order of Abatement

The Code Enforcement Officer attended the International Code Conference in March.
