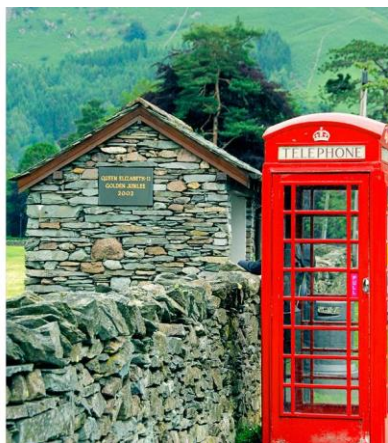

Day 5: Wednesday, October 2, 2019

York - Borders Region, Scotland -

Edinburgh Enjoy a leisurely morning in York before traveling north through the rolling fields to bonnie ("lovely" in Scottish) Scotland. Stretching across the country you will find Hadrian's Wall, once the mark of the northern border of the Roman Empire. Stop to see this ancient fortification that was begun in A.D. 122 to protect Roman Britain from the tribes of Scotland. Next, drive through Scotland's Borders region before arriving in Edinburgh, the "Athens of the North." Discover Scotland's exciting capital, and one of Europe's most beautiful cities, alive with history and culture. Tonight, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 6: Thursday, October 3, 2019

Edinburgh Today **it's your choice!**

Get acquainted with this regal city on a locally guided all-encompassing tour of the city via coach **-OR-** join a local expert and explore the city on foot. Both tours include visits to Edinburgh Castle, home to the Scottish Crown Jewels, and the Palace of Holyroodhouse,* the Queen's official residence in Edinburgh and the former home of Mary, Queen of Scots. The rest of today is yours to explore the city independently. (B)

Day 7: Friday, October 4, 2019

Edinburgh - Lake District, England -

Ruthin Castle, Wales Our final stop in Scotland comes at the border town of Gretna Green, where generations of runaway couples came to get married. Later, return to England and travel through the picturesque Lake District. Here in the district's heart, visit the charming village of Grasmere, home of the poet William Wordsworth. famous Military Tattoo show. Please inquire at time of reservation.

This tour requires average physical activity. You should be in good health, able to climb stairs and walk reasonable distances, possibly over uneven grounds and cobblestone streets.

Air passengers will arrive and depart from London airports. On day 10, all transfers will depart from Stratford-upon-Avon for London airports.

Please be advised many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Due to transfer scheduling, flights on the last day of your tour should be scheduled after 11:00 a.m.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

A deposit of \$500 per person is due upon reservation. Reservations are made on a first come, first served basis. Reservations made after the deposit due date of March 22, 2019 are based upon availability. Final payment due by July 30, 2019. Deposits are refundable up until March 29, 2019.
