





A summer staple within the community, the Sanilac County 4-H & Youth Fair has been held in Sandusky for over ninety years, with the first fair taking place in 1932. In ten short years, thousands of people flocked to the area in hopes of taking part in some of the many activities available. From horse pulling and livestock sales, to tractor pulling and operating contests, there has always been an emphasis placed on agriculture. It wasn't until 1942 that the property upon which today's fair is hosted was first used. 15,000 attendees at the tenth annual Sanilac County 4-H Free Fair witnessed as the now extinct Fair society deeded the county's various 4-H clubs the land, allowing for generations upon generations of children to benefit.

4-H is the largest youth development organization in Michigan. Over 200,000 young people are actively involved in its list of nearly twenty plus programs. Ages nine through nineteen are welcome to participate in such categories as the arts, STEM, life skills, outdoor education, and more. Within Sanilac County, one program that remains irreplaceable is the animal science division. Every year, during the so-called "Dog Days" of summer, Michiganders from far and wide make the move to join in on the competition, showing off and sometimes selling their livestock.

Fourteen-year-old Blake O'Connor has been taking his lambs, pigs, and prospects to the fair since 2018. As part of the Kountry Kids club—which is led by Applegate secretary Traci Frostic—this summer will be his fifth year showing. O'Connor was encouraged by his father to get involved in the program.

"It's very fun and a great learning opportunity, but a lot of hard work," he said.

Despite being a popular destination for residents, it's no secret that fair week tends to get busy. While most people enjoy starting their day off with a little more light, it's not unusual to find O'Connor already up and ready by 7:30 AM.

"I wake up to feed the animals, do chores, and then chill for a while. . . then, I do chores again," he said. "The worst part is cleaning the pens."

He may enjoy spending time with his animals, but make no mistake, he also enjoys riding plenty of rides and taking the time to involve himself in the liveliness of the week. Those part of the livestock program tend to get pretty competitive, though. Like many part of 4-H, O'Connor is just one member who has had to develop a strong work

ethic to be able to participate. This is true of Max Noll, a fourteen-year-old competitor also part of Kountry Kids. Much like O'Connor himself, Noll has been showing since he was nine-years-old and has plenty of experience in the show ring.

That was not always the case.

When asked about how he felt when he first started competing, Noll explained that "[He] was actually very nervous!"

This feeling is universal when it comes to many 4-H members. Whether it has something to do with the thrill of the chaos or the fear of making a mistake in front of everyone, one thing is certain: the ring is a place where members can show off everything they have learned over the past year. It is a culmination of the "head, heart, hands, and health"—those four pillars that the organization is built upon.

In the hours leading up to the show, along with shaking off those nervous jitters, all participants have a mental checklist that they tend to keep, and it goes as far as to include attire. While dairy program competitors are required to wear white—a tradition that has been around since the beginning of the fair—it's open game for O'Connor and Noll. Since they are part of the livestock program, their clothing usually consists of a button up shirt, a pair of jeans, and some boots. After slipping into something more comfortable and prepping their own animals so that they can look their best, the hardest part involves taking that first step into the ring. From there, depending on the animal being shown—whether that be sheep, pigs, cows, etc.—members are required to lead them through a series of commands before answering some basic questions about their animals.

"There are a lot of hurdles to jump through, and it was definitely scary the first time," Noll said. "But, I would recommend it."

The Sanilac County 4-H & Youth Fair remains a vital piece of Sandusky's history for adults and children alike. There is no better example of this than the effort put forth by the organization during the COVID-19 pandemic. In 2020, the fair was canceled for the first time since its initial founding. With how tenuous the course of the pandemic was at the time, in addition to the uncertainty about the precautions that needed to be taken, those on the fair board made the tough decision to offer a virtual fair in August. Current members were encouraged to submit videos or pictures of their fair projects, including such things as crafts, livestock, and more.

Over 130 entries were received during the submission period. The fair was eventually held in person again in 2020, but the flood of positive feedback led to the creation of the state's first statewide virtual showcase for all 4-H participants. With a legacy that has been intertwined with one of Michigan's most prolific organizations, the 91st Sanilac County 4-H & Youth Fair is expected to be better than ever. Community members, 4-H participants, and more are welcome to come and experience the area. From August 6th–12th, the fair will be in full-swing, and all 4-H hands will be on deck.

Consider stopping by and seeing some of the animals or even asking about the resident clubs—anything would be better than having to clean the pens.
