SANILAC COUNTY YOUTH & 4-H FAIR PART OF A NEARLY 100 YEAR TRADITION

Sandusky and its surrounding community are no strangers to change. Most groups tend to go through their own growing pains, whether that be in terms of people building new structures, moving around, or even changing hands. This is particularly evident regarding the recent road construction, which has forced locals to adapt to twisting detours and rotating schedules. Such developments may seem monumental, but they are not the biggest changes to have occurred in the city's history. That title belongs to the introduction of the Sanilac County 4–H Free Fair over ninety years ago in 1932.

For nearly a decade, people from across Michigan gathered in Sandusky to participate in horse or tractor pulling, livestock sales, and operating contests. When the property upon which today's fair is hosted was deeded to the county's 4–H clubs, over 15,000 people stood by and watched as future generations were endowed with new opportunities.

For nineteen-year-old Kristina Fleischman, opportunity (and change) have been an inevitable part of her 4–H experience. She joined a Bit O'Mischief at eight years old and has been traveling to Armada, Croswell, and Sandusky ever since. With eleven years of experience under her belt, she is what most might call a "jack of all trades," having shown pigs, cavy (guinea pigs), poultry, goats, sheep, rabbits, and cats.

"It's kind of difficult sometimes to juggle it all. When I did my first show, I was really nervous but also excited. I remember showing my leader's goat, Jersey," she said. "She was like the same height as me!"

4-H got its start a little over 318 miles from Sandusky in Clark County, Ohio, with the emergence of the "Tomato Club," otherwise known as the "Corn Growing Club," in 1902. While not as inventive as later club names like a Bit O'Mischief, this youth program—the first of many—allowed students to engage in hands—on learning experiences. Many of which have been incorporated into current members' showing techniques.

"It gets competitive," Fleischman noted. "The way you dress, where you hold your halter or lead, and how your animals look . . . It's all important. You pick up on the rules as you go."

That does not stop her from adding her own flair, though.

"When I show, I make sure to smile big so that it has an impact on the judges." $\,$

But 4–H is about much more than agriculture or showing. The details are fuzzy, but it is believed that Jessie Shambaugh, a former teacher and superintendent in Page County, lowa, created the "Page County Progressives," the birthplace of many of the creative endeavors that would flourish within 4–H.

Fleischman herself has dipped her toes into the world of photography, tie-dye, and other crafts. These activities might sound quite simple, but that is not the case.

The homemaking process involves different classes and categories, along with questions about the materials used or time spent.

"You've gotta make sure that you really want to do this," Fleischman explained. "Honestly, you're gonna be nervous. I try to keep my mind off of things. Practice, practice, practice, and just do your best."

The variety of programs within 4–H has grown since 1902, with the Sanilac County Youth & 4–H Fair alone offering over thirteen departments; however, the COVID–19 pandemic impacted many of them. Today, there is less competition, and while that might seem like a good thing for those hoping to take home a ribbon, it also means that fewer animals are participating. This is much the case for the Cats Department at the Sanilac County Youth & 4–H Fair. Fleischman and Bailey have been involved for four years, having watched competitors come and go.

"You have to have at least five participants, but there's only been three for a while," she said. "There are probably not gonna be cats this year . . . Not a lot of people know you can show them."

It was during the peak of the pandemic that the fair was forced to close for the first time in the history of its creation. This left dozens of 4–H members wondering just one thing: What were they to do? Fair board members attempted to alleviate these concerns by offering the 2020 Virtual Fair. Of the 130 entries received from July through August, Fleischman's submission was one of them. She had the opportunity to participate as an Intermediate Showman.

Aside from the lack of competitors in the ring, the process was similar to if it had been done in person.

"My mom took a video of me, and I just had to walk my goat around," Fleischman commented.

Exhibitors were also required to wear proper attire in their 60to 90-second videos. For the goats, that included a white collared shirt, black pants or shoes, and tied-up hair.

"They didn't place you or anything, but I got some participation points for it," she continued. "You got a shirt, too."

It has been four years since then, and despite the many changes introduced by the road construction, the fair is slated to be better than ever. With this year being its 92nd anniversary, there is no time like the present to join in on the festivities.

Consider attending the Sanilac County Youth & 4-H Fair from August 4th–10th or contacting your local MSU Extension Office to speak with club leaders.

Take it from Bailey and Fleischman: 4–H is not just for those interested in agriculture; it is for those curious about anything and (sometimes) everything.
