The public will take Notice that the Burnsville Town Council shall hold a work session Special Meeting pursuant to NCGS 160a-71 and NCGS 143-318.13(b) on February 1, 2021 at 1p.m. in the Burnsville Town Center located at 6 South Main Street, Burnsville NC 28714. The purpose of the meeting is to:

1. Discuss Burnsville's water/sewer infrastructure.
2. Discuss current and upcoming projects.
3. Discuss RFQ for on-call engineering services.
4. Update on the Special Order of Consent.
5. Discuss goals/strategic planning for staff, operations and facilities of the Town other than water/sewer infrastructure.
6. The board may take action on any of these items or instruct staff to move forward with tasks or projects.
