

## RESCISSION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR THE TOWN OF BURNSVILLE

**WHEREAS**, on March 10, 2020 North Carolina Governor Roy Cooper issued Executive Order 116 declaring a State of Emergency in North Carolina due to the Coronavirus pandemic.

**WHEREAS**, Yancey County issued a declaration for a Local State of Emergency to address the Coronavirus Pandemic on March 16, 2020.

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of the Town of Burnsville issued written request and consented to the application of Yancey County's Local State of Emergency within the municipal jurisdiction of the Town of Burnsville on March 15, 2020.

**WHEREAS**, on August 15, 2022 North Carolina Governor Roy Cooper issued Executive Order 267 rescinding the State's Declaration of State of Emergency.

**WHEREAS**, on August 8, 2022, at 6:00 p.m Yancey County terminated their declaration of a local State of Emergency within the jurisdictional limits of Yancey County.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Mayor of the Town of Burnsville under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes:

**Section 1.** I hereby rescind the Local State of Emergency Order issued within the jurisdiction of the Town of Burnsville on March 15, 2020.

**Section 2.** I hereby order this declaration: (a) to be distributed to the news media and other organizations calculated to bring its contents to the attention of the general public; (b) to be filed with Clerk to the Town of Burnsville and (c) to be distributed to others as necessary to ensure proper implementation of this declaration.

**Section 3.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Proclamation is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Proclamation.

Effective this the 16th August, 2022.
