

Southern Area HBCU Servant Leader All Star Scholars

Scholarships will be established to further the Southern Area's mission of forming servant leaders and support students who are examples of leadership for the good of others.

Eligibility:

HBCU undergraduate and graduate students in all disciplines are eligible to apply

- 1. Financial need will be taken into consideration as demonstrated by the filing of a complete and accurate Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- 2. Evidence of servant leadership as provided in the service/leadership resume (See essay question on application for more about what "servant leadership" means).
- 3. Statement of servant leadership as provided in an attached essay, based on the topic given.
- 4. Letter of recommendation from someone who can attest to evidence of your servant leadership.

Recipients of the Servant Leader Scholarship are expected to provide a minimum of 20 service hours each semester. The service opportunities will be supervised by local Links Chapters and may be a part of the chapter's ongoing programming.

Renewal of the awards is not guaranteed. Rather, eligibility will be based on program participation, maintenance of enrollment status as full-time student) and a minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA. Amounts of scholarship may vary from one year to the next, based on the funding available.

Scholarship awards may be combined with other scholarships and grants

Award amounts may vary. Deadline to apply is May 20, 2021. Please email completed forms and accompanying documentation to Programs@salinksinc.org.

Letter of recommendation

Attach a letter of recommendation from someone who can attest to your service and/or leadership experience. Examples of letter writers include pastors, youth group leaders, scout leaders, civic leaders, service organization leaders, and individuals you have served.
