“Chicken Trot” Thanksgiving Drive This Saturday

LC Valley Indivisible (LCVI), a local grassroots organization dedicated to supporting and uniting the community, is hosting its first-ever **Chicken Trot** this Saturday, November 22 -- a fast-paced, one-day push to collect funds for Thanksgiving meals for local families.

The Chicken Trot is a community “mad dash” to gather the resources needed for complete Thanksgiving dinners, including **roisserie chickens, pumpkins, and classic holiday sides**. All proceeds will directly support **Community Action Food Bank**, helping them serve families across the LC Valley.

The drive will take place **Saturday, November 22, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.** at the **Asotin County Library Community Room**, in the library’s downtown location.

LCVI will be collecting **Venmo and cash donations** and **WinCo/Costco gift cards**. Community members are also welcome to drop off nonperishable food donations.

Thanksgiving Sponsorship Levels

Community members and local businesses are invited to participate at any level:

- **Chicken Champion -- \$5.** Supports a fresh rotisserie chicken to serve as the centerpiece of the Thanksgiving table.
- **Dessert Donator -- \$6.** Provides a pumpkin pie for dessert.
- **Green Bean Giver -- \$10.** Helps cover essential sides for a Thanksgiving meal.
- **Cranberry Contributor -- \$25.** Supports multiple sides that round out a family’s holiday table.
- **Pumpkin Pie Patron -- \$100.** Funds a full meal kit—including sides and dessert—for a local family.
- **Harvest Hero -- \$150.** Supports complete Thanksgiving meals for multiple households.
- **Valley Feast Sponsor -- \$250+.** Makes a major impact by helping stock the food bank with proteins, pies, and bulk sides.
