

Proposed changes to parking lot and landscaping requirements

Current (2021-13 et al.)

Bans the following species in landscaping:

Mimosa, bamboo, English ivy,
running monkey grass, large leaf vinca,
wisteria (Chinese), Chinese privet,
Japanese honeysuckle, tall fescue, Bradford pear,
Non-native lespedeza, Chinese tallow tree,
congongrass

Use with caution:

Nandina (heavenly bamboo), garlic chives,
Devil's walking stick, artemesia, trumpet creeper
Obedient plant, sweet autumn clematis,
Mexican hydrangea, Queen Ann's lace,
wintercreeper eupnymus, chameleon plant,
cypress vine

Proposed (2025-xx)

Replaced by list of plants identified as invasive by the
University of Arkansas Division of Agriculture

Minimum of 3 feet of landscaping along
front of a building and sides

Landscaping features to be incorporated into building sides
that require a façade

Commercially zoned buildings must be approved for
compliance with landscape and façade requirements
before a building permit is issued
