

PLAYOFF SCENARIOS BOYS

Bombers clinch 3 seed with:

1. Bombers beat Greenwood by 10 or more + Alma Win + Farmington Win

Bombers would go to a coin flip against Van Buren if MH wins by 9 to determine 3 and 4 seeds

Bombers would clinch at least 4 seed IF

Bombers beat Greenwood by 5 or more + Alma OR Farmington win

IF Bombers win by 5 and Siloam Springs loses then we would have a coin flip to determine 4 seed.

Bombers would be out win:

1. Loss to Greenwood
2. Win by 4 or less against Greenwood
3. Win by 10 or more and Van Buren defeats Farmington AND Siloam Springs defeats Alma
4. Win by 6-9 over Greenwood and Siloam Wins over Alma

ALL COIN FLIPS WILL BE DONE IN PERSON FEATURING THE TEAMS INVOLVED IN THE COIN FLIP AND AN ADMIN FROM EACH TEAM.

IF US, SILOAM SPRINGS, AND/OR VAN BUREN FINISH WITH THE SAME RECORD HERE ARE THE TIE BREAKING PROCEDURES ACCORDING TO SECTION 6.6 OF AAA HANDBOOK:

Rule 6. TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE.

A. If two teams are tied from regular season conference play, tiebreaker procedures will be:

1. Head to head in regular season conference play.
2. If the two teams have split, margin of victory between the two teams, with a maximum of 10 points per game.
3. If the two teams are still tied, all winning conference game points, with a maximum of 10 points per game.
4. Forfeited games. Offended teams shall receive 10 points when tabulating the sum of the winning margins for breaking conference ties.
5. If the two teams are still tied, a coin flip by the Arkansas Activities Association's Executive Director or his designee will decide seeding.

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B. If three or more teams are in a tie from regular season conference play, tiebreaker procedures will be:

1. Head-to-head competition

2. If a team has been defeated by one of the other teams twice (or once when a single round robin is used), they will be eliminated.

3. If two teams remain, the teams would go to step two listed above in Paragraph A.

4. If step two does not break the tie, step three would follow, then step four, then five. If three teams remain, the teams would go to Paragraph C.

C. If three or more teams are tied and each team has split (or a perfect triangle), each position will be

decided using the two team tie-breaking procedure in Paragraph A to determine which two teams go

head to head for the first available position. First, tabulate the margin of victory in all conference

games (up to 10 points per game). The two teams with the greatest margin of victory in conference

games shall utilize the procedure in Paragraph A to determine the first position available.

Use the

same process to determine the second position available and all other positions available for the

teams involved in a three or more team perfect triangle tie.

IF BOMBER BOYS MAKE IT:

If the Boys are a 3 seed they will play at 2:30 on Thursday against Greene County Tech, Girls would play right after at 4. (Girls are locked in at that time, they can not move up or down.

If the Boys are a 4 seed they will play on Tuesday at 5:30 against Marion
