OUR COMMITMENT


Over 100 years ago, the YMCA of Greenwich opened its doors to welcome our community in its collective pursuit of a healthy lifestyle. Our YMCA has been a cornerstone of the community since 1916. Situated in the heart of Greenwich, it is a hub of wellness where 5,600 members come together to collectively strengthen mind, body, and spirit. Each day, over 1,100 people come through the doors to connect with their "Y Family" in pursuit of a healthy lifestyle.

Today, our community seeks solutions to complex challenges as individuals pursue the same goals of healthy mind, body and spirit. The YMCA will respond with the same unwavering commitment to community wellness that inspired the establishment of our organization.









OUR NEED

Usage in both of our pools has consistently outpaced capacity throughout the last decade. Programming demand continues to increase rapidly, thus requiring a facility whose operations perform to the highest of standards more consistently.

Each and every individual who enters our YMCA facility should have the confidence that their experience at the YMCA is nothing short of excellent. We must modernize our equipment to ensure delivery of a superior and consistent experience.

In May 2019, the YMCA Board of Directors authorized YMCA leadership to retain top global design & engineering firm Stantec (NYSE: STN) to conduct a comprehensive assessment and define detailed solutions for sustained, efficient improvement.

The Board's objectives were clear:



Identify trusted and proven systems to ensure superior water and air quality



Incorporate vendor supported preventative maintenance into operating budget



Reduced carbon footprint through greater utility efficiency

The study was extensive and all encompassing. Sound solutions emerged and were unanimously approved by the board. Specific recommended areas of enhancement include:

High efficiency Multistack® chiller that supports the entire facility	\$800,000
Olympic Pool scoreboard and timing system	\$100,000
AlumniPool Seresco® dehumidification system	\$575,000
Olympic Pool bulkhead:	\$250,000

OUR PLAN

With swift financial support from our community, the YMCA will sign contracts by November 2019 to procure and install the necessary upgrades by June 2020. The call to action is critical. Our Board of Directors will only authorize commencement of projects that are fully funded at the time that contracts are to be signed.
