Today we are a 100% volunteer force of over 200 people from all walks of life who make sure we take care of families in Ipswich with school age children. We have many committees which support, shopping, birthdays, holiday delivery, Market Basket gift certificates, career support, senior citizen visits and school supplies. This is all accomplished with community donations and small grants. This year, in view of Covid precautions, we have come up with a plan to buy winter coats and boots for our 200 children. Parents will collect these on Saturday Nov 21 from 9-12 at the Ipswich Town Hall "take-out food style." Mission: Beverly Bootstraps provides critical resources to families and individuals so they may achieve self-sufficiency. Beverly Bootstraps offers emergency and long-term assistance including: access to food, housing stability, adult and youth education, counseling and advocacy. Programs like Back to School Backpacks, Thanksgiving dinners, and gifts at the holidays are just a few examples of our community backed programs that support our clients.

History: Beverly Bootstraps is a leading social service agency on the North Shore that started as a Food Pantry in a downtown Beverly church in 1992. In 1995, Beverly Bootstraps formed a community outreach program to address the root causes of hunger and assist clients in achieving self-sufficiency. In 2000, our Adopt-A-Family Holiday gift program was started to provide gifts to low-income children. Since then, thanks to support of the community, the program has grown to provide gifts to more than 550 children annually. In 2003, we opened our Thrift Shop to offer affordable clothing and goods to clients and residents. And in 2007, we expanded services to residents of Manchester. In 2008, we moved our offices and services to 371 Cabot Street in Beverly so that all programs could be managed at one central location. In 2009, as the need grew during the Great Depression, the number of clients we served tripled! In 2016, our current location at 35 Park Street, was purchased and renovated and our Thrift store was expanded. In 2017, we celebrated our 25th anniversary and in 2018 we collaborated with Acord Food Pantry to bring case management services to the Hamilton-Wenham community. Through it all, the community has been our source of motivation and gratitude, they have been by our side since the beginning. Thanks to our supporters, our current location at 35 Park Street, located in downtown Beverly is easily accessible to clients and volunteers. This new building is a hub for education, food assistance, tax assistance, fundraising and shopping at the Thrift Store. We continue to be grateful to the community that continues to generously support us.
