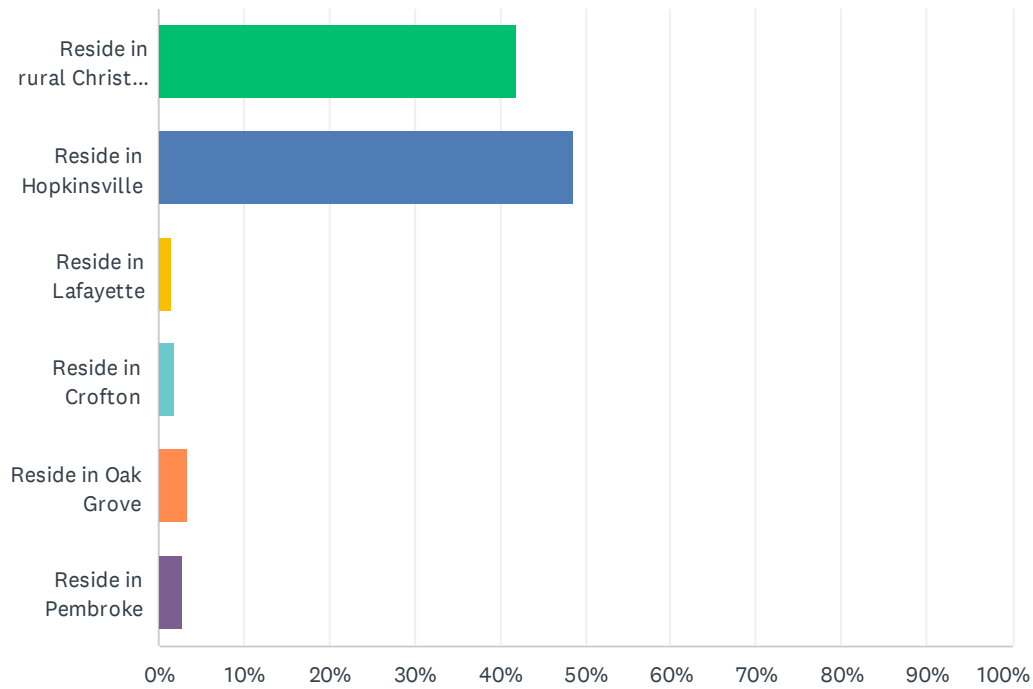


Q1 What best describes your permanent residence?

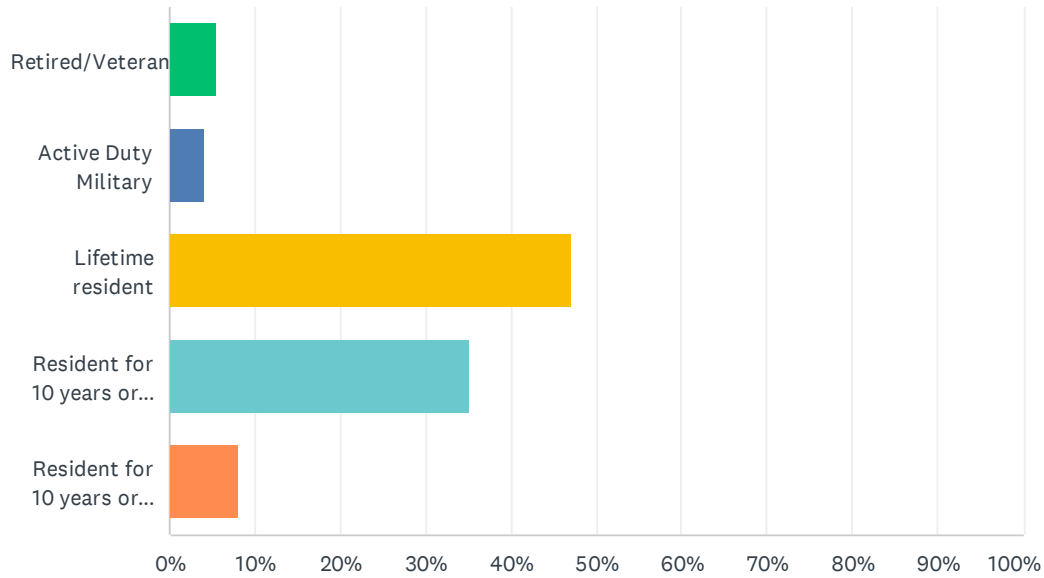

Q2 What brought you to Christian County?

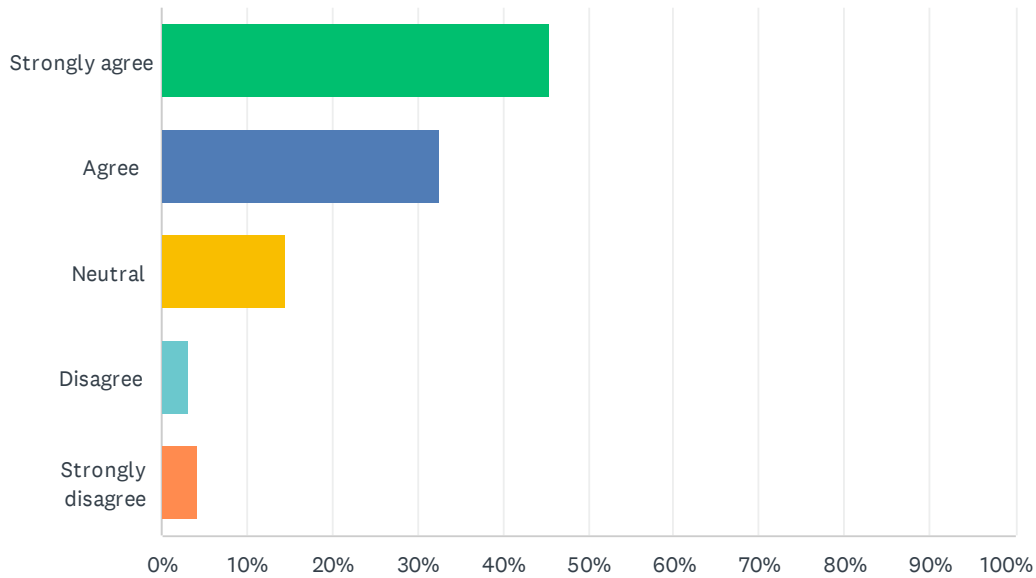

If there is help needed in other areas the first ones pulled are the ones that work at the shelter so that leaves the shelter struggling to care for the animals properly. The lack of space, proper maintenance, and much needed upgrades hurt every person and animal involved. The new director is very knowledgeable and truly cares for the animals but she is not open to advice or opinions from the rest of the staff. She openly shows favoritism and promotes the employees that follow her blindly over ones that have more seniority, knowledge, and experience. She makes up new rules or policies as she goes and will outright lie to justify them. The shelter is in much need of cleaning and organizing. There is no inventory tracking so they are constantly running out of some necessities and overstocked with others. Supplies are not kept in the same or easy to find locations but just shoved into random areas. Stock is not rotated or tracked which causes a lot of waste. The full time employees do the minimum amount of work and are not willing to help each other if one is overwhelmed. They will push there duties off on someone else or just not do them but record that they were done. Proper protocols are not clearly posted in areas they should be	12/22/2023 6:27 PM

performed. Very few are willing to help when others are overwhelmed and they have the time to do so. The different offices/areas are inconveniently placed which hinders the processing of new intakes. New hires are not properly trained or supervised. They are left to learn on their own do the care and cleaning is not consistent, properly done, or just skipped. If it's not in their job description they won't do it. Employees that are favored can get away with anything while the others are nitpicked and made miserable until they quit or are forced out. There is a supervisor with no leadership skills that's too afraid to correct anyone and makes constant mistakes that have harmed animals and gets overwhelmed at the slightest things. She is not good at her job at all and will stop in the middle of important procedures to answer personal phone calls. She will stay on the phone when there is work to be done. So things are just left undone until hours later or not done at all. Employees that truly care and are motivated are under appreciated and overworked which causes frustration and burnout. The staff is clearly divided and the director waxes and wanes. If the public were to see some of the areas that are hidden or that they are discouraged from entering they would be disgusted. The new director is very intelligent and excellent at many of her responsibilities but terrible at treating the staff equally and avoids areas that need vital improvements that would make the care of the animals easier and more consistent. There are several spaces/offices that are overcrowded and not appropriately used while others are underutilized and could be used for the animals to play/exercise instead of spending 24 hours a day stuck in small, smelly, and loud kennels for days/weeks at a time.
