## CEDAR RAPIDS CRIME STATS THROUGH NOVEMBER 30, 2024

The safety and security of every Cedar Rapids resident and visitor is our foremost concern. In an effort to highlight monthly, year-to-year, and five-year trends in crime and positive outcomes from proactive policing efforts, we are releasing this information on key crime topics around the city.

These six stats offer the best picture of where the City stands with regard to crime:

- Homicide
- Aggravated Assault
- Burglary
- Theft from Vehicle
- Theft of Vehicle
- Shots Fired

Data through November 2024 continue to show positive progress in a total reduction of Shots Fired, Violent Crime, and Property Crime. If current trends continue, Cedar Rapids will close out 2024 with notable improvements in most crime categories.

Officers and Investigators continue to find weapons in the possession of those ineligible - generally during calls for service. The most common reasons for being deemed ineligible stems from drug possession or intoxication.

Shoplifting remains a concern for retailers and we continue investigating these crimes. We are finding some success in identifying and making arrests of shoplifters with businesses who install high-quality camera systems, and those with vigilant staff who can alert CRPD staff in time to intervene. CRPD's District Lieutenants are available to discuss the needs of business owners who wish to install camera systems intended to help mitigate retail loss.
